The accident happened about five o'clock on the Sid Boothe farm one mile east of El Dorado.

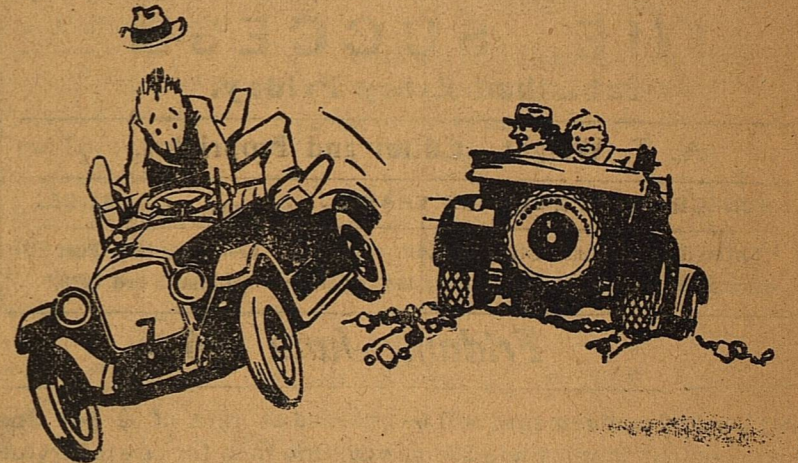

## MAKING A GOOD TOWN BETTER

While the administration at Washington is talking about economy and the reduction of taxation by cutting national expenditures, it is well to watch the other end of economic leaks, the curtailment of unnecessary waste on the part of the people themselves. Should not economy begin at the bottom as well as at the top.

Recently a better mailing week, was inaugurated to conduct a nation-wide campaign to reduce the appalling loss through carelessness in addressing and wrapping mail matter. It was pointed out that 21,000,000 letters and 803,000 parcels went to the dead letter office last year! It costs our cosmic Uncle the neat sum of \$1,740,000.00 a year just to look up addresses on misdirected mail.

There is little consolation in the theory that the postal system pays for itself. It does not even do that and every loss through carelessness on the part of the public not only reflects itself in increase of postal rates but saps from the national treasury to make up the deficiency. Upwards of \$2,000,000 must be added to the annual running expenses of the Post Office Department because you and I are either careless or innocently negligent.

When we begin to regard the postal system as something more than a machine, and our local postal employes as something less than superior beings and mind readers, we will begin to wrap and address our mail more carefully and thus cut off a needless loss from our national expenditures. As was pointed out by Postmaster General Newcomb, a man always knows his own address whether he knows his correspondent's or not, and can at least identify his letter or package in the upper left hand corner.

It is not far fetched to bring these points to bear in helping to make a good community better. Whatever helps the nation as a whole helps every community in it. Whatever is saved for a department of your government is saved for you, because the saving reflects itself in lessened taxation and less need for revenue; and the post office is closer to the people than any other branch of administrative government.
