



It isn't possible if she has to phone frantically for the butcher, the grocer and the baker.





DIETITIANS declare that the average boy or girl of four years should receive about forty calories a 20 head of horses, the sale will pound of body weight per day. The be on Satuaday Januray 16th, average weight of a child of four years is forty pounds. Therefore the total caloric requirement would be ap proximately 1,600 calories. Calory is merely the name for a certain measure of heat derived from the burning of food.

Necessarily, the caloric requirement of the child is dependent on his temperament, since a child whe plays hard and long requires more nourish ment than one who leads a quieter ife. Rate of growth also has a bearing on caloric requirements. The child who is growing rapidly should e given more food to meet his caloric needs than the boy or girl whose rowth is normal. Mothers know the daily diet should onsist of the essential foodstuffs, pro-

tein, carbohyrates, fats, minerals and water. The important thing for her is to learn the foods that contain these essentials in a balanced diet. Below is a well-balanced menu for any child six years old compiled by an authority on home economics.





Chief Inspector Sounds Keynote to Purifying Nation's Milk Supply

At the 14th annual convention of | At the 14th annual convention of the International Association of Dairy and Milk Inspectors held at Indianapolis, recently, leading au-thorities of the United States and Canada submitted interesting and in-formative papers relative to the puri-fication of the nation's milk supply. In the closing session of the series

In the closing session of the series of meetings, Dr. Roy F. Leslie, Chief Meat and Dairy Inspector of Cleve-land, Ohio, emphasized the great importance of co-operative measures by the producer in the production of by the producer in the production of clean milk.

"With co-operation on the part of the milk producers," said Dr. Leslie, "much can be done along this line that would otherwise be impossible." He then teld of how the public was kept informed of steps taken to control the milk supply with a view to safeguarding the health of all who use milk and dairy products.

"In Cleveland," said Dr. Leslie, "more than 70% of the milk is sold at one or another of a system of chain stores where the customer is given an allowance of 2 cents on the purchase of each quart of milk."

The 2 cents allowed covers the cost of delivery in the home and repre-sents a saving of about 12% to the consumer.

It is certain that the results of this work are reflected to a great extent in the increased consumption of mill: by the people of the United States, and this increased consumption is sure to be reflected in monetary ad-vantages for both the producer and


