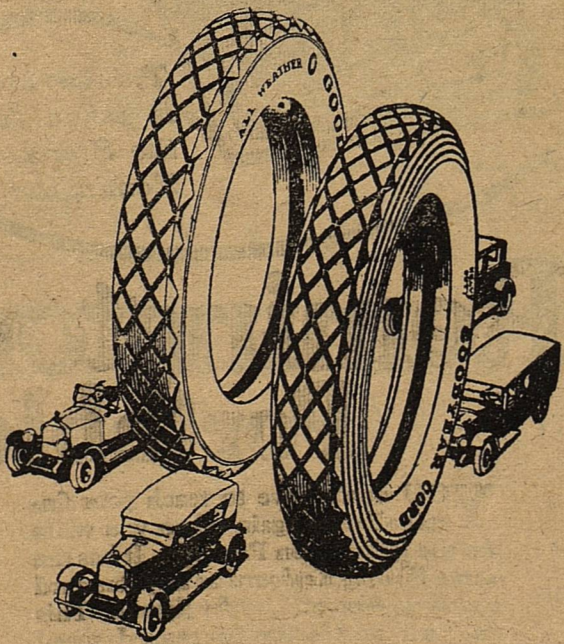

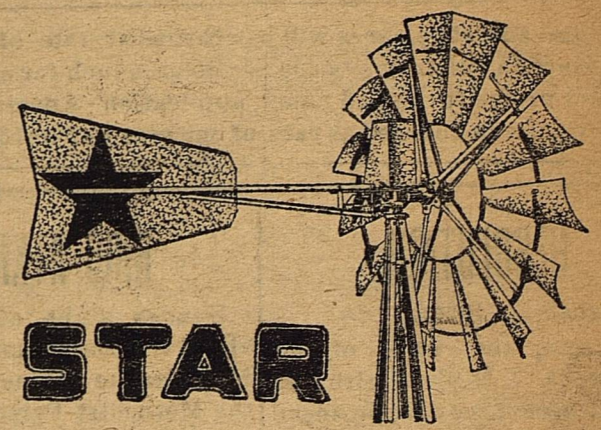
## STATE WINS IN SUIT AGAINST HOFFAMN CO.

Venue of the State's \$421,000 road suit against the Hoffmann Construction Company belongs in Travis County, the jury reported Saturday at 5:58 p. m. In reaching this decision, the jury found "probable fraud was committed in Travis County," in connection with the \$1,500,000 surfacing contract let the Hoffmann Company April 28 by the Highway Commission.

In deciding for the State, the jury overruled defendants' pleas of privilege that the suit should be tried in Eastland County. Because of the congested docket of the 53rd District Court, it is likely at least a month will elapse before the case goes to trial on its merits.

## Auto Hosts One-Sixth as Great as U. S. Population



IT'S a far cry from the full skirts, wasp waists and leg o' mutton sleeves of twenty-five years ago, but we have traveled also a long way from the two-cylinder gas wagon of 1900 to the high-powered motors speeding over our highways today, declares the Stewart-Warner Safety Council.

A quarter of a century ago there was one automobile for every 9,500 people in the United States. Ten years ago there was one automobile for every 33 people, while today the motor population is one-sixth as large as the human population, or one car to every six people. This rapid growth has put the automobile as foremost among American industries, but it has also produced a fearful menace to the public, points out the Safety Council which has for its purpose the prevention of automobile accidents. A vigorous campaign of public education must be pushed if annual rate of automobile fatalities is to be reduced from 22,000.

## FORDSON TRACTOR

### TO RUSSIA

The last 10,000 Fordson tractors, the largest order ever placed, which were purchased by Russia, have just been delivered to representatives of the Russian Government in New York it was stated today at the Ford Motor Company, Highland Park general offices. The entire order was filled, at the River Rouge plant of the company within a period of approximately seven weeks. During the time that the Russian consignment was being produced, tractors for domestic absorption were also being manufactured as usual.

At approximately the same time as the last ship laden with Fordsons clears port in the United States, the first of the tractors which were built on the latest order will have reached Russian interior. The complete consignment will be delivered in time for the opening of spring tillage. Together with the tractor which had previously been ordered by the Soviet government this new order will increase the number of Fordson in use in Russia to approximately 172,000 units all supplied within the past three years.

Practically the entire shipment was routed through New York to the Ports of Novorossisk and Odessa on the Black Sea for distribution. The remainder was routed through Seattle for Vladivostok.

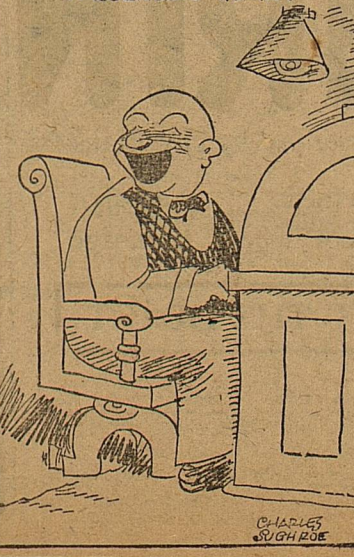

## AN ORDINANCE.

Regulating the traffic and passing of bicycles, animals, automobiles and other vehicles over portions of streets in the incorporated town of El Dorado, Texas and defining such portions of streets and requiring any person riding a bicycle, animal or driving an automobile or other vehicle upon certain streets of said town of El Dorado to keep to the right of the center thereof and turn same so as to cross the center of the street only at intersections when making a turn over certain portions of the streets of said town of El Dorado as herein set out and making it unlawful for any person having charge of any automobile or other vehicle to park same or permit same to be parked in any position other than at an angle of forty-five degrees with the edge of the street and so that the nearest portion of such automobile or other vehicle shall be within two feet of the curb line of such street and defining upon what portions of the streets of said town of El Dorado such regulations shall apply and providing a penalty for the violation of the foregoing provisions.

Be it Ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the incorporated town of El Dorado, Texas;

Section 1. All bicycles, animals, automobiles and other vehicles ridden or driven on the portions designated in Section 2 hereof of the streets of the incorporated town of El Dorado, Texas, shall be ridden or driven on the right hand side of the center of such portions of streets, except in turning at intersections in the manner permitted in Section 3 hereof.

Section 2. The foregoing regulation shall apply upon that portion of every street within the incorporated limits of said town of El Dorado which coincides with and is traversed by the public road known as State Highway No. 30.

Section 3. In turning from one street into another at intersections of any other street in said incorporated town of El Dorado, Texas, with those portions of streets in said town which coincide with and are traversed by the public road known as State Highway No. 30, bicycles, animals, automobiles and other vehicles shall be ridden or driven as to keep to the right of the center of such intersection.

Section 4. Any person violating any of the provisions of the foregoing sections of this ordinance shall be fined any sum not exceeding One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.

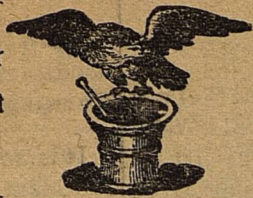
