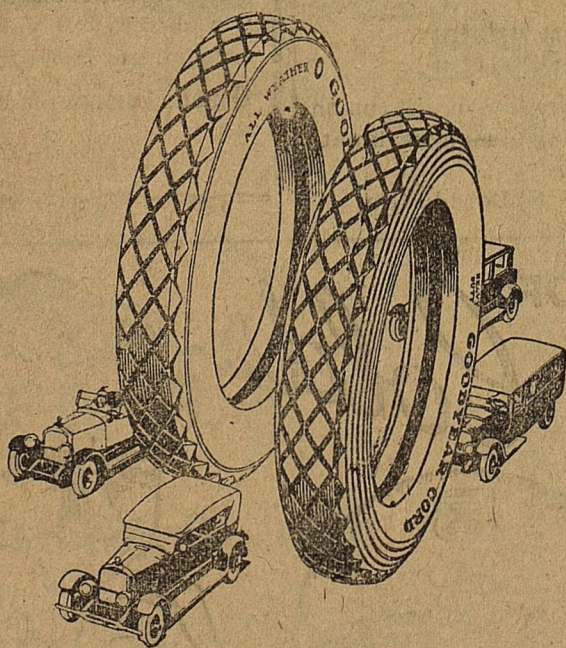

AGRICULTURAL CONFERENCE AT DALLAS.

To All Farmers, Farm Organizations, County Agents, Teachers, Editors and Bankers of Texas.

The time has arrived for prompt and proper action in behalf of our agricultural interests. Agriculture and all kindred industries are threatened with bankruptcy if present agricultural practices are continued. A bumper cotton crop this year with consequent low prices and short feed crops will surely bankrupt the State. A better system of farming and marketing is imperatively demanded.

For the purpose of co operation and united action in solving agricultural problems, we hereby call a State Wide Agricultural Conference to be held at the Baker Hotel in Dallas, Texas at 10 o'clock a. m. Saturday, January 22rd, 1926, for the following purposes.

1. To encourage the reduction of cotton acreage during the year 1926.
2. To encourage the growing of better staple cotton.
3. To encourage the planting of enough feed crops to supply the State.
4. To encourage the the proper rotation of crops and building up of the soil.
5. To formulate plans for a county and school district organization to accomplish the purposes above enumerated.
6. To discuss marketing problems and such other related subjects as may properly come before the Conference
7. To elect delegates to South wide Agricultural Conference

ASKING AID FOR TEXAS INCLUDING WEST TEXAS

Washington, Jan. 11.—Members of the Texas delegation in Congress have little hope that the Federal Government may be induced to assume the full cost of fighting and stamping out the foot and mouth disease, as has been urged by the live stock interests of Texas. Before the holiday recess. Representative Garner appeared before the House Appropriations Committee advocating that because Texas had not been responsible for the entrance of the foot and mouth disease and had no means of preventing it, the State should not be called on to bear half the expense as under the present Federal policy.

On Wednesday Representative Hudspeeth, Briggs and Jones appeared before the House Appropriations Committee in support of the State being released from the cost of combating the cattle plague, but were met with objections from members of the committee that if such policy were adopted in the case of live stock, it would necessarily follow.

Repurchase of the famous Bosque County ranch by former Governor James E. Ferguson from Dan A. Japhet became known late Saturday afternoon, the consideration was \$100,000. No actual money was passed, the former governor giving a series of vendor's lien notes for the entire sum. The first of notes for \$25,000, falls due on January 2, 1927. The rest of the notes, six in number, are for \$12,500 each, and fall due on January 2 for six successive years, beginning in 1928. All of the seven notes bear 6 per cent interest. Mr. Japhet came into possession of the Bosque County ranch through a loan of \$75,000 on which he made the former governor in 1921. He foreclosed the mortgage in 1924. Mr. Ferguson has rented the ranch from Mr. Japhet since the loan was foreclosed. Mr. Ferguson owned the ranch when he first ran for governor in 1914. It contains 8900 acres.—The Brady Sentinel.

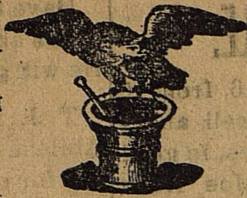

ASKING AID FOR TEXAS.

low in fighting all other agricultural pests. Members of the committee gave no hope of any thing more liberal than the present plan of co operation with the States. It has been the position of Texas people that the Government should shoulder all the fight with reference to pests that came from other countries, another instance being that of the pink bollworm.
Mr. Jones also urged the committee to give an increase appropriation to the weather bureau, which would enable the gathering of greater number of weather reports from Western Texas and Western Oklahoma. An additional sum of \$4,000 would answer the purpose, he said. It was explained to the committee that cotton growing had become one of the leading industries in West Texas and Western Oklahoma, and of the importance of weather reports on cotton industry.

The committee was urged by Mr. Hudspeeth to restore the \$7,000 appropriation which the Budget Bureau eliminated for the Big Spring agricultural experiment station, and restoration of the fund to \$583,000 for fighting predatory animals on the Western live stock ranges. The committee indicated that both of these sums would be restored.—Dallas News.
