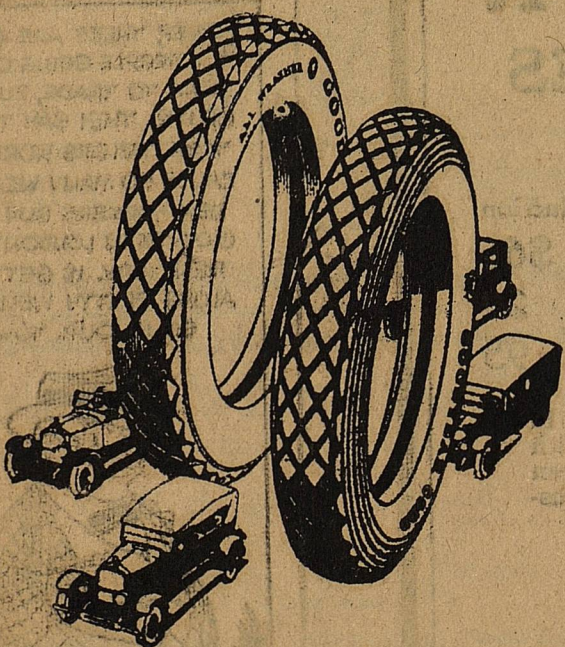

BUCK BAILEY VISITS IN ABILENE.

Buck Bailey, called the greatest guard in America today by most coaches and sport writers who saw him in action against the fastest teams on the Pacific slopes last season, as well as against the All-Eastern team and Grange's Chicago Bears, was in Abilene Tuesday visiting his brother at Simmons and his old friend and pal, coach Victor Payne of Simmons university.

Although Bailey, who is known here principally because of his exploits as tackle on the Abilene Christian college eleven of 1920, has played with the Olympic club of San Francisco for several seasons, the past was the greatest in its history. He was captain of the Olympics, who won all of their 12 games, was captain and coach of the all-Western team that defeated the all-Eastern team which had stars from 15 universities east of the Rockies, and crowned the season by leading the San Francisco Tigers in a 14 to 9 victory over Red Grange's team in Frisco on Jan. 24 before a crowd of 25,000 that overflowed the stadium.

Among the teams defeated by Buck's Olympic club eleven were the University of California, which was administered its first defeat in 5 years. The score was 15 to 0. Leland Stanford fell 9 to 0 and victories also were scored on Santa Clara U., the California Aggies, St. Ignatius college, All-Star navy eleven and the Hawaiian Island all-stars, who were defeated in Honolulu 41 to 0.

At the close of the Olympic club season Bailey, who tips the scales at near 225 pounds and is fast and strong with it, signed to coach and captain the all-Western team in the Shriners hospital benefit game with the eastern boys. The California aggregation was the winner.

Speaking of Red Grange Buck says that he is a prince of a fellow, just a common every-day guy whose head is not the least bit turned by the unparalleled publicity he has received.

Of course everybody expects him to run 900 yards more or less, every time he carries the ball. Nobody can come up to what is expected of him but I'll say one thing he can get to the scrimmage faster than any man live," declared Buck.

He wouldn't explain how Grange was stopped in the Frisco game but newspaper reports from there explained that old Buck himself had a lot to do with that. And he had a great team with him. The Tigers' line-up was: George Wilson (Washington U.) and Fitzke (Idaho), halves; Rabbit Bradshaw (Nevada U), quarter; Stockton (Gonzago), full; Brown (Olympic club) and Reed (Organ U.), ends; Shipke (Stanford) and Bean (California) tackles; Noland (Santa Clara) and Lecey (Oregon Aggies) guards; Bailey, center. Buck played offensive center and took Locey's guard on the defense.

After a short visit with his parents at Eldorado, Texas, Buck came here to visit Coach Payne and his brother, who is in school at Simmons. He left Thursday night for Fort Worth. Bailey's athletic career started at Texas A. & M. where he earned the cognomen of "Fish" because it took one half of Bible's varsity line to stop him. After service in the army during the war he came to Abi-

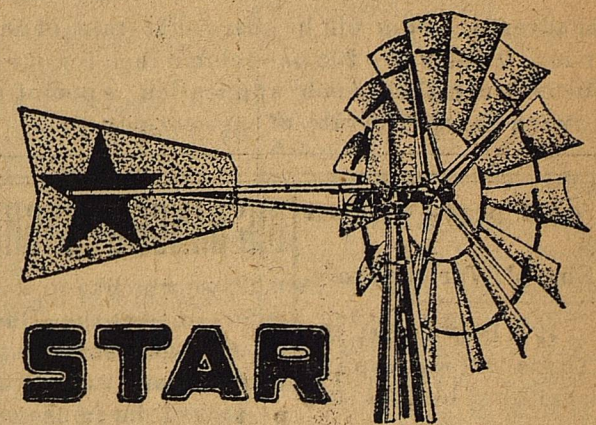
A. B. BARRET SPEAKS ON EVOLUTION.

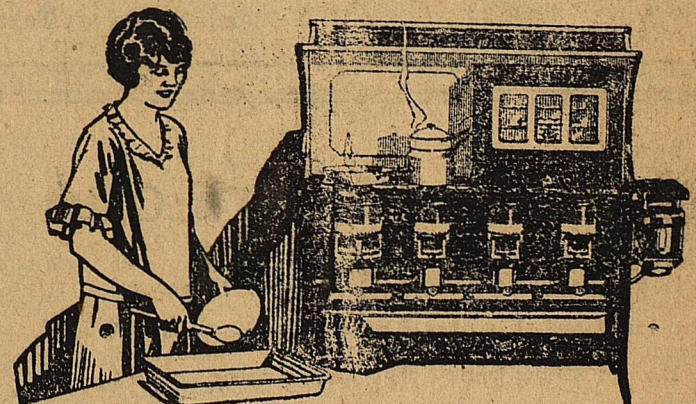

AN ORDINANCE.

Regulating the traffic and passing of bicycles, animals, automobiles and other vehicles over portions of streets in the incorporated town of El Dorado, Texas, and defining such portions of streets and requiring any person riding a bicycle, animal or driving an automobile or other vehicle upon certain streets of said town of El Dorado to keep to the right of the center thereof and turn same so as to cross the center of the street only at intersections when making a turn over certain portions of the streets of said town of El Dorado as herein set out and making it unlawful for any person having charge of any automobile or other vehicle to park same or permit same to be parked in any position other than at an angle of forty-five degrees with the edge of the street and so that the nearest portion of such automobile or other vehicle shall be within two feet of the curb line of such street and defining upon what portions of the streets of said town of El Dorado such regulations shall apply and providing a penalty for the violation of the foregoing provisions.

Be it Ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the incorporated town of El Dorado, Texas;

Section 1. All bicycles, animals, automobiles and other vehicles ridden or driven on the portions designated in Section 2 hereof of the streets of the incorporated town of El Dorado, Texas, shall be ridden or driven on the right hand side of the center of such portions of streets, except in turning at intersections in the manner permitted in Section 3 hereof.

Section 2. The foregoing regulation shall apply upon that portion of every street within the incorporated limits of said town of El Dorado which coincides with and is traversed by the public road known as state highway No 30.

Section 3. In turning from one street into another at intersections of any other street in said incorporated town of El Dorado, Texas, with those portions of streets in said town which coincide with and are traversed by the public road known as State Highway No 30, bicycles, animals, automobiles and other vehicles shall be ridden or driven as to keep to the right of the center of such intersection.

Section 4. Any person violating any of the provisions of the foregoing sections of this ordinance shall be fined any sum not exceeding One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.

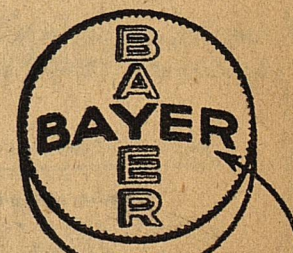

Suspensions About Wall Street and How They Arise

By FRANCIS H. SISSON, President

WOULD-BE economists, political orators and the general public make frequent positive assertions about the functions of Wall Street without any realization of what constitutes Wall Street or what purpose it serves. Lack of knowledge breeds suspicion. Yet it is not difficult to understand the nature and function of Wall Street. Let us set down a few of the facts which account for the existence and nation-wide, as well as international, services of Wall Street.



There are 316 banks in New York with combined capital and surplus of about \$1,400,000,000. Their deposits aggregate over \$11,500,000,000, and during 1924 their total volume of business reached nearly \$250,000,000,000. The New York Stock Exchange in 1925 sold 463,000,000 shares of stock and in 1924 \$3,828,000,000 worth of bonds. Wall Street is the national credit and money market. It is just as essential that there be markets for money and for

the facilitation of trade, industry and investment are upon a correspondingly ample scale. It is clear that these funds must be employed sanely, constructively and to the real service of the business community. Otherwise they would inevitably soon be withdrawn.

Huge Investments Help Farmers
These huge investment operations in Wall Street are of significance to the farmer. Much of the \$10,000,000,000 invested in farm mortgages was advanced by Eastern financial institutions. In no sense is Wall Street's interest in agriculture local or sectional. The main function of New York financial institutions is to send money where it is most needed.

Another service rendered to agriculture by Wall Street is the purchase of Farm Loan Bonds, Joint Stock Land Bank Bonds and the debentures of the Intermediate Credit Banks. There is a total of \$1,451,800,000 of this paper outstanding, of which New York banks took about one billion.

Wall Street loans to country banks are made at low rates, usually below 4 1/2 per cent. The local banker's rates to his customers are adjusted to local conditions, which cannot justly be laid at the door of Wall Street.

General financial service to other industries related to agriculture also helps the farmer substantially. Wall Street loans to the packers, railroads, millers and farm-machinery manufacturers to help them serve agriculture.

Wall Street is as necessary and serviceable in the handling of credit and capital as is the cold-storage plant in caring for seasonal perishable products. The necessity of such a credit center in a country with a \$60,000,000,000 annual business is obvious.

What the People Want
Every great international bank in New York maintains close relations with thousands of other banks in the United States and in every foreign country of any importance. The movements of commerce and investment are supported upon this inter-related system of domestic and foreign banks. Thus it comes about that the products of the farm, factory and mine are financed by these banks all the way from the producer to the foreign consumer.

Wall Street in the discharge of its true functions as the nation's reservoir of capital and credit includes the whole business community in its field of operations. Its control lies with the people. Their demands govern it, and their presence or absence from the market determines its trends. Wall Street prospers as farming and industry prosper. Its service is to the people of the whole country and, for them, to the people of other countries. It is the direct reflection of American agriculture, industry and commerce.
