## Crop Insurance For Crops By 1970 Height

The state committee of the Federal Crop Insurance met April 13, 1968, to begin an all-out effort to bring Federal Crop Insurance coverage for Eastland County in 1970.

Federal Crop Insurance is offered by — and backed by — the United States Department of Agriculture. The insurance program is administered by the Federal Crop Insurance Corporation. The program has been in operation for several years and covers some 25 different crops in 10 states.

Federal Crop Insurance against losing yield, damage, fertilizer, pesticides, other production materials. Farmers are guaranteed a price large enough to pay all expenses. The farmer's crop is insured against losses of loss excepting growing practices.

Farmers do not have to be paid in advance. Farmers can wait until harvest time to pay, with no interest or other charges for delayed payment.

Insurance rates are set by the community approved based on the risk of growing the crop. No administrative costs are charged against premium. All premium due is either paid back to the farmer or set aside for future use.

Sign petitions by local farmers, business men and other rural people must be submitted to the Federal Crop Insurance Corporation in Washington, D. C., or review in order to determine local insurance coverage.

## INTRODUCTION

Two Texas counties, Eastland and Comanche, are centers of the most important peanut growing area in the Southwest. It is the purpose of this study to demonstrate the opportunities which exist for utilization of this valuable raw material in the manufacturing of peanut products in the Eastland-Comanche Area and, specifically, in the communities of DeLeon, Eastland, Gorman and Ranger.

This study begins by exploring the structure of the peanut industry. Then the economic determinants of peanut products manufacturing which exist in the Eastland-Comanche Area are analyzed and evaluated, and the opportunities for peanut butter, salted peanut, and candy production in the Eastland-Comanche Area are defined.

Every effort was exercised to obtain information from the most reliable sources, but Texas Electric Service Company assumes no responsibility for the decisions which may result from its use.
