Run-Off Primary Sat. Decided Two County Races

In the two county races to be decided in Saturday's run-off primary, J. Frank Tucker and John Hart won over incumbents J. B. Williams and P. L. Crossley. In the sheriff's race Tucker won the election by slightly more than 80 votes and Hart had a majority of about 600 votes in the judge's race.

Williams had led the first primary by over 1,000 votes while Hart had a majority of something over 300 votes.

Voting was light in the second primary. Officials stated that about 1,000 votes less were polled in Saturday's election than in the first primary in July.

Oil Prospect Is Seen For Area South Of Carbon

Prospects are reported as being bright for the completion of a flowing oil well in the area 4 miles south of Carbon. The new prospect is the Stekla and Chandler's No. 1 Bob Harper, a deep wildcat test.

The well was bottomed at 3,558 feet in the Ellenberger lime. The well was treated with acid last Friday morning and they are now swabbing through tubing.

No information was available on the amount of oil and gas present, but they are anticipating a nice well.

Ranger Offers Prize For First Cotton And Peanuts

Ranger, Texas.-The farmer bringing in the first load of 1950 peanuts to be marketed in Ranger and the one bringing in the first bale of cotton, 1950 crop, to be ginned at the local gin, will each be \$50 richer, according to W. F. Creager, chairman of the agriculture committee of the Ranger Chamber of Commerce.

These bonuses will be given by the Ranger firms through the Chamber's agriculture committee, and the Ranger firms will also donate \$100 toward defraying the cost and expenses of an Eastland County Peanut Exhibit at the State Fair of Texas this fall, Creager states.

The first load of peanuts to be eligible for the \$50 prize must weigh 10,000 pounds or more, grade 70 or better, have sound, mature kernels containing less than 9 percent moisture. The test will be made by a Federal State approved grader stationed in Ranger.

J. H. (Hoover) Pittman of the Flatwood community was the winner of the prize for bringing in the first load of peanuts last year. It weighed in on Sept. 23.

No bonus was given for the first bale of cotton last year due to the fact that the local gin got a late start, but the gin will be ready to go early this year and a good run is anticipated by the owners. T. D. Lauderdale, a gin man of many years experience, will again operate the gin.

AROUND THE HOUSE

Vinegar in the water used to boil or poach eggs will keep the eggs firm. Also, in the case of an aluminum pot, the vinegar will help to prevent the pot from turning color.

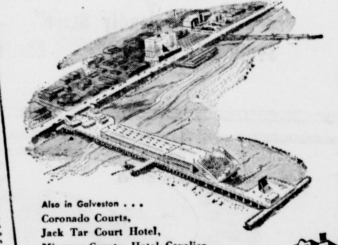
