He had no wind erosion, and even his coarsest textured sandy soil, which, because of its high location, is more exposed to the wind, than any of the surrounding farms.

### Farm Topics

#### Electric 'Cowboy' Will Aid Ranchers

Economic Way to Keep Stock on Home Pastures

Come spring, an electric "cowboy" will ride the range to help farmers and ranchers keep their stock in the pasture and out of planted fields.

This cowboy is the old stand-by 6-volt Winchester "Hot Spark" battery that years ago gave a balky model T a frosty-morning pickup. according to W. S. Allen, general manager of the electrical division of Dlin Industries, Inc., who is a farmer to boot.

Little or no knowledge of electricity required as reliable fence controllers approved by underwriters, which keep the current going to the electric fence intermittently long times a minute, come with simple instructions easy to follow.

Electric fence wire can be moved from one location to another, but it is best to make permanent installations. Metal or wood fence posts are suitable. Posts to fence horses should be from 40 to 80 feet apart. Twenty-five to 40 feet apart is satisfactory for smaller animals.

In states where barbed wire is legal, it is usually preferred. Like any other electric fence wire, it should be fastened to the posts by insulators and should not come into direct contact with posts, weeds or the ground. Inexpensive solid type, but never split type, glass or porcelain insulators should be used rather than old rubber or necks of bottles.

Substitutes are a poor economy as they don't work well or last long. Where gates are required, attach the wire to a spring to maintain tension and continue the wire through the center of a wood or rubber handle to a hook to fasten to a continuation of the wire on the other side of the gate.

How high the wire should be strung from the ground depends upon the size of the animals to be fenced. Generally, you measure the distance to the ground from about the middle of the animals' head when grazing. Following are fence heights for various animals:

- 6 to 16 inches... pigs
- 12 to 18 inches... calves
- 10 to 18 inches... sheep, goats
- 30 to 36 inches... cows
- 30 to 40 inches... horses

**God Has a Plan**

Lesson for May 28, 1950

**GOD HANDS DOWN** no blueprint. He never yet has been willing to save any man the trouble of thinking. The Bible is God's guidebook, and in it is revealed that the Bible is a guidebook of such a sort that you can take it from the shelf and look up in it the answer to every one of your problems in detail. Nevertheless the Bible is a guidebook. "The inflexible rule of faith and practice" as some churches express it.

God's will is shown there plainly enough so that we can know whether we are building on the right foundation or not.

**Sins Into The Sea**  
 NOW THE PLAN of God is so simple, that is, it can be so simply expressed, that one is almost tempted to say, "Oh, that" as if it were something we knew already. Well, we do know it. But the thing is, we don't do it.

Part of God's plan for mankind, a very important part, in fact indispensable to the fulfillment of the Bible talks about from the beginning to end—is this. The forgiveness and the destruction of sins. (Micah 7: 18-20.) Now everybody can see others' sins.

The Romans used to say that every man carries others' sins in a bag in front of him where he can see them very well, but his own sins he carries in a bag hanging down his back where he can't see them.

We are all in favor of other people's forsaking their sins. But how about you? The world does need to confess its own sins. No sins walk by themselves; sins exist only in sinners. Sin does not commit itself. Sin is something a sinner does. We shall never get rid of sins by exhorting other people. We get rid of them by repenting in the presence of God.

**If Not Peace, Then What?**  
 WE ALSO KNOW something about God's plan for society at large. The Bible does not leave us in the dark. One thing that Micah brings out is the ideal of peace. (Micah 4:1-5.)

So long as we are making war, preparing for and expecting war, doing or saying things that make war inevitable or even likely, we are out of line with the will of God. Conversely, whatever we do to foster peace is in line with the plan of God. War was bad enough in the days of Micah; it is incalculably worse today.

War always was the effect and cause of hate, it always brought suffering and death, war seldom settled anything. Any war nowadays is a war against the whole human race, for any large-scale war with atomic weapons may well make the entire globe uninhabitable by man. A voice for war is a voice for universal death.

**Christ The King**  
 CHRIST THE KING is a warless S'ward; such is God's plan. Is this possible? Only on one condition: that Christ shall be King. (Micah 5:2-4.) This has two meanings, one far-off, and one near; one complete and one partial. The far-off, completed meaning (which may be nearer than we think) is that after the history of this planet is over and done with, in the "new heavens and the new earth" the final destiny of God's people is to live under the Lord Christ as leader and king.

The nearer, here - and - now meaning of Christ's kingship is this: Wherever, in the plans of men, the spirit of Christ, his way and his ideal, is being trampled on or ignored, there God's plan is forgotten and there disaster is certain.

But wherever the spirit of Christ is in control, there God's plan is being carried out and there the Kingdom of God is coming nearer.
