Marines Enlisting Young Men For One Year Tour

Eastland Dec.—The Marine Corps is still enlisting young men of eighteen for a one year tour of duty, Master Sergeant William L. Poole, Marine Recruiter at the Eastland County Courthouse has announced.

Quotas for regular 3 and 4 year first enlistments are being filled early in the month but the regular Marine Corps still has some openings for 18-year olds and ex-Marines.

From 4 to 9 months of formal schooling are being offered to one year enlistees in the Marine Corps. Service school facilities and aviation fields have increased to allow a high percentage of young men to receive specialist training.

Schools are available in nearly all the fields of civilian and military endeavor such as: Clerical, Engineer, Ordnance, Repair, Automotive Repair, Supply Clerical, Photographic, Electronics, Aviation, and Cooking and Baking.

Warning Is Issued On Worthless Checks

A wave of worthless checks has hit Eastland County along with the rest of the nation, Sheriff J. B. Williams warns.

The sheriff said that many of the fraudulent checks are showing up in his office every week and that although the check passers are often caught in the long run, the money involved is rarely recovered.

He warned merchants and any others cashing or accepting checks to make sure of the personal identities of the persons passing them, and to use all other precautions to avoid being swindled.

A great majority of the worthless checks on which he receives complaints, the sheriff said, are accepted by people who have not made a sincere effort to identify the check passer.

Livestock Information From Veterans Class

Those who own dairy and feed cattle will notice little knots on the backs of their cows. This is caused from the heel fly biting the heels of the cattle in the spring. The egg hatches and the larva works up to back of the cattle in the fall causing what is known as cattle grubs. These may be killed by rubbing the backs of the cattle with Derris powder.

Many farmers hogs are bothered with lice and mange at this time of year. A new product developed during the war called Chlor-dane will kill both lice and mange. Follow directions on bottle.

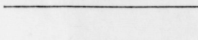
QUESTION: The floor of our trailer home is covered with an asphalt covering which is rather kinked worn. Would you recommend laying tile over this covering, or taking up the old and starting from scratch?
ANSWER: A good floor-covering contractor probably would prefer to take up the old covering because it might make an uneven base for the tile. He would know best about that, however, after seeing the actual condition of the present covering.

QUESTION: Is there a paint to seal leaks in a roof by painting over the roofing?
ANSWER: Leaks often can be stopped by the application of an asphalt roofing cement. A roofer can do this job for you. But if the roof leaks all over, a new roof would be more advisable.

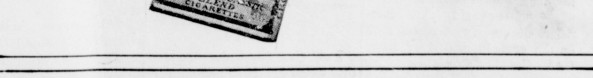

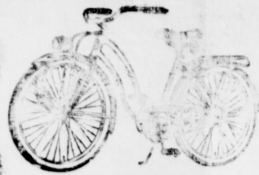
