Government Predicts High Incomes for 1949

Noting that personal incomes set a record this year, the Bureau of Agricultural Economics reported that 1949 incomes should be just as high, even though they might slip a bit toward the end of the year. The bureau also foresaw a continued boom in employment.

Meanwhile, the Federal Reserve board said the buying power of the nation's farmers was now more than twice what it was before the war.

It estimated that 10 per cent fewer persons were working on farms at the end of 1947 than before the war, while non-farm population had risen nearly 20 per cent since 1937.

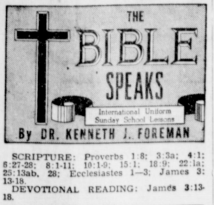

True Wisdom
Lesson for October 31, 1948

WHAT is the most important thing in the world? What is worth more than anything else? Some would say Money; some Power; some Goodness; some Truth. Another answer is given by the writers of a group of books, two of which are included in our Bible, "Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore get wisdom," they say.

The books of Dr. Foreman Proverbs and Ecclesiastes in our Protestant Bible, and the book of Ecclesiasticus and the Wisdom of Solomon in the Apocrypha, all have this viewpoint and are therefore called the Wisdom Literature.

Other writers in the Bible divide the human race into the Good and the Wicked, or the Believers and the Unbelievers, but these writers see mankind as the Wise and the Foolish. The books they wrote (especially Proverbs) were intended particularly for those who are so far neither foolish nor wise—that is to say, the young.

Knowledge Is Not Wisdom
WISDOM (as these writers use the word) is not the same thing as knowledge. A person may know a great many things and still be a fool. Or he may not even know how to read and write, and yet be wise. Some modern writer has said: Knowledge is knowing what to do; skill is knowing how to do it; and virtue is doing it. Wisdom is all of these put together.

But the special feature of the "Wisdom Writers" is this: True wisdom begins with the fear of God. "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom... the knowledge of God is his understanding." In other words, wisdom without religion, without faith, is foolish after all.

We can see how in our times the story of the Nazis has shown this one more to be true. The German Reich of 1933-1939 had the best of the science of the world; they had scholarship and wealth and "know-how" in many fields; but they rejected God and defied his church—and so a nation was destroyed.

We too may profit by their example. We of the western nations have wealth and technical skills beyond any other peoples, we have the atom bombs—but have we the wisdom without which all these things are but as torches in the hands of madmen?

University on Anti-Hill
KNOWLEDGE may be expensive. It costs a great deal of money to know what takes to be an engineer or a surgeon. Wisdom, strange to say, is less expensive. The more you know, the "Wisdom Writers" tell us we may learn wisdom. One place is experience. "Experience keeps an expensive school, but fools will learn in no other—and hardly from that," says a more modern proverb.

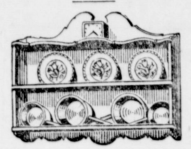
Many of the proverbs in our Bible are simply distilled drops of experience. "A soft answer turneth away wrath, but grievous words stir up anger," for example. Do you need an angel from the sky to tell you that? Another source of wisdom is just Nature herself. "Go to the ant, thou sluggard! (lazy fellow); consider her ways and be wise." A lazy man is a fool; but how shall he learn to be wise? Not by reading books—just by watching the ants.

Some people think that Inspiration is always mysterious, and that the Holy Spirit would not stoop to inspire what we could learn in any ordinary way. But the Christian church, when it declares Proverbs her belief that there is such a thing as Inspired Common Sense.

God may speak to us, and does speak—we will listen in the advice of our parents, in our everyday experiences, in the hard-working ant and the majesty of the soaring eagle. All truth is God's truth, even when we find it in our own backyard.

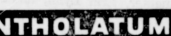

Sharp Characters Act At Ease With Others

WHY is a sharp character sharp and why is a sad sack sad? Why do some guys and girls seem at ease with others? Why do others with just as many assets seem to be beating their brains out trying to decide what to do with their hands?

"Beat your gums—but not so loud," she advises. "A shrill, loud voice is curdling to the spirit. On that same subject, resounding giggles and horselaughs are strictly for the birds."
