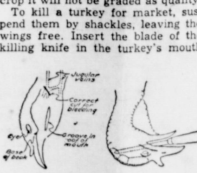

Process for Killing Turkeys Explained

Proper Slaughtering And Bleeding Required

Before killing turkeys, as well as other fowl, see that they have access to water but no feed during the 12 to 18 hours prior to slaughtering. When the turkey shows feed in the crop it will not be graded as quality. To kill a turkey for market, suspend them by shackles, leaving the wings free. Insert the blade of the killing knife in the turkey's mouth

and make one clean cut across the upper part of the throat just back of the junction of the head and neck, as shown in drawing.

Hold the turkey head down, with the beak open, until the blood is well started. With the left hand grasp the head in front of where the cut has been made to prevent the pressure of the fingers from checking the flow of blood. Poor bleeding is indicated by visible blood in the veins and by the dark red appearance of the carcass after picking.

When the blood is flowing freely, thrust the knife blade straight back on a line between the eyes and ears, through the cleft in the roof of the mouth and into the lower lobe of the brain. Give the knife a quarter turn. This kills the bird and loosens the feathers.

Herds and Flocks on Successful Farms

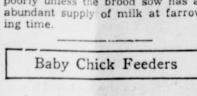
Feed banks for cattle should be 30 inches high for mature stock and 24 inches for calves. Allow 30 inches of trough length for each grown animal, 20 for each calf. Make the grain and silage bunk three feet wide for feeding from both sides. Many ewes die every winter from a condition known as pregnancy disease. The losses are not so common in flocks where the ewes are kept gaining slightly in weight during the gestation period.

Well-conditioned ewe that should cause no trouble.

Lousy cows, when freed from lice, give 10 per cent to 15 per cent more milk, according to Michigan State college. This means the equivalent of another cow in a herd for \$1, by controlling lice. In winter, which is a bad time for cattle lice, apply a powdered louse killer containing DDT and repeat the application in 10 to 14 days.

Early spring litters of pigs do poorly unless the brood sow has an abundant supply of milk at farrowing time.

AROUND THE HOUSE

The amateur painter can apply enamel easily and without leaving brush marks if he will first heat the paint in a pan of warm water. Brushing a small area at a time is sound practice.

Never scour china or pottery. Hard rubbing and cleansing powders may cause the color to fade and damage the smooth finish.

Knits in the thread when hemming table linens may be avoided simply by running each needleful of thread through a piece of paraffin before sewing with it.

Linens to be stored should contain no starch. Wrap them in deep blue paper to prevent their turning yellow and store them in a dark place free from dampness.

Silks and woolsens are generally folded or rolled so that the right side is inside.

When you make a fruit pie that's likely to run over, put a cookie sheet under it. The cookie sheet is much less likely to be clean than the inside of the oven.

Single Hair Convicts

Murderer of Crime

While criminal investigators can rarely state that a certain hair came from a certain person, a case occurred recently in which a single hair, found at the scene of a homicide, led to the positive identification of the murderer, says Collier's.

After hairs taken from three suspects were found, in a microscopic examination, to be nearly alike in length, diameter and color, they were subjected to ultraviolet light which caused the hair in question and that of one suspect to emit a purple fluorescence. The glow was produced by aspirin which the man took daily in such quantities that traces of it had worked into his hair.

THE BIBLE TODAY International Union Sunday School LESSON BY LOUIE D. NEWTON, D.D. SCRIPTURE: II Peter; Jude; Luke 2:40-52. DEVOTIONAL READING: Matthew 5:3-16.

Building Character Lesson for November 16, 1947

WE SHALL need to read carefully Second Peter if we are to profit most in the study of Sunday's lesson. Peter tells us:

"According as his divine power hath given us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue."

We may partake of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption of the world through the knowledge of God.

In addition to Second Peter, we are asked to read Jude and Luke 2:40-52. The passages in Luke tell how Jesus grew and waxed strong in spirit, filled with wisdom; and the grace of God was upon him.

As Jesus Grew WE HEAR a great deal today about juvenile delinquency. The question everywhere arises, What can we do to prevent juvenile delinquency?

We have the answer in Sunday's lesson. As Jesus grew in wisdom and stature and in favor with God and man, so can every young American grow into strong and beautiful manhood and womanhood.

The parents of Jesus, we are told obeyed God in doing for the Child all that they were commanded to do.

The Lev. of God KEEP yourselves in the love of the Father. This is the formula for building Christian character.

This business of building Christian character is based on a formula—keeping within the circle of God's love.

It is just as essential to have the proper nourishment in building Christian character as in growing a fine ear of corn. Progress is not accidental. It is the result of right thinking, right behavior, right purpose.

Christian Mathematics TURN again if you will, to Second Peter, and read his mathematical formula by which Christian character is realized.

"Add to your faith virtue, and to virtue knowledge, and to knowledge temperance, and to temperance patience, and to patience godliness, and to godliness brotherly kindness, and to brotherly kindness charity. For if these things be in you, and abound, they make you that ye shall neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ."

And what is that our needy, frightened world is asking for above everything else today? For the certitude of hope that is found only in hearts that are staid upon God.
