Check Your Own Social Security Records Is Urged

While the Social Security Administration has the responsibility for maintaining approximately 126 million earnings records, Mr. Weatherly, Field Representative of the Abbeville district office, pointed out today that it is the responsibility of each individual social security card holder to check his record periodically to make sure it is correct.

Mr. Weatherly also stated that everyone should check his social security record at least once every three or four years. In most instances the Social Security records become final and not open to adjustment after three years from the end of the taxable year for which the earnings were reported. There is another point to be considered too — the matter an error is found, the sooner it can be corrected. This applies to everyone whether he is working in his own business or for someone else as an employee.

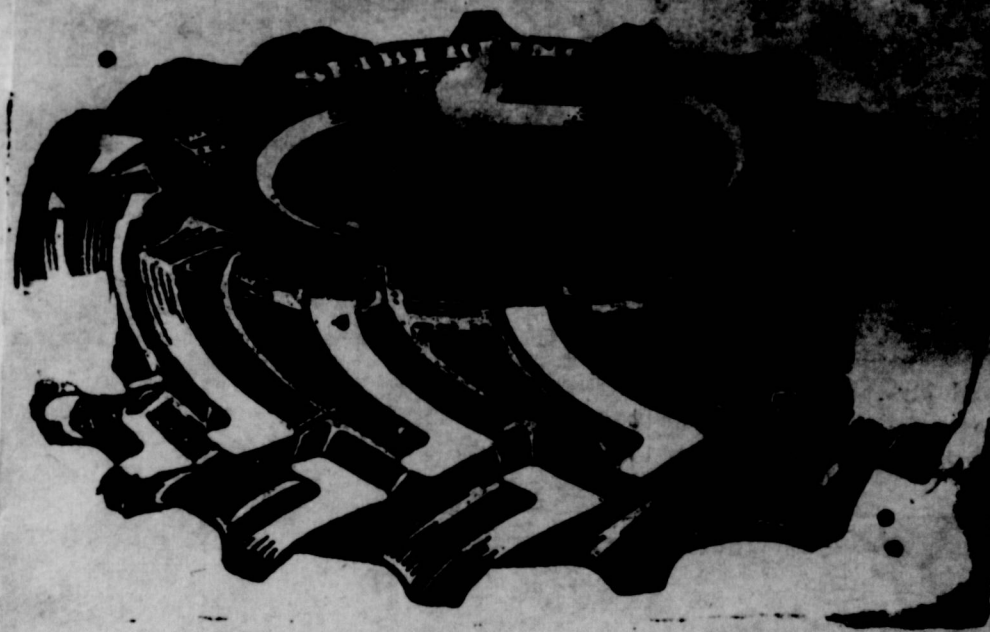

Eastland High School will be dropped to Class 1-A in next year's football conference play, leaving District 7-AA with Cisco, Ranger, Ballinger, Coleman and Winters, according to reports here today.

The Mavericks will play in District 10-A with Albany, Early of Brownwood, Clyde, Cross Plains and Santa Anna. Interscholastic league rules require schools with less than 205 in high school to play in Class 1-A. Eastland's daily average attendance is just under 200.

Principal C. B. Midkiff said

the Lobos hope to keep Eastland on their schedule for 1960 and are endeavoring to play them early in the season. He added that District 7-AA schools will meet soon to work out their conference schedules. Supt. Arlin Hint of Cisco is serving as chairman of District 7-AA schools.

Eastland's assignment to Class 1-A was for two seasons. If their attendance increases, they will return to the higher classification.
