Fat Lamb Class Due To Attract Record Number

The fat lamb class at the annual Eastland County Livestock Show to be held at that city March 29 and 30th is again expected to be the largest in years due to the popularity of the project among FFA and 4-H Club Boys, according to C. M. McCain, general show superintendent.

Over 100 lambs from all parts of the county are expected to be shown. They will be judged on a packer basis at 9:30 a. m. on the second day of the show. Jimmy Kehoe, Fort Worth, buyer for one of the largest meat packers in that city will place the lambs as either prime, choice or good in grade.

Boys with lambs grading prime will receive \$5.00, while those grading choice will get \$3.00 and those with lambs grading good will get \$2.00. As the lambs are graded they are marked with blue chalk to designate their grade. A grand and reserve champion lamb is picked from those grading prime.

Clinton Ray Humpries, Eastland, will be in charge of this class.

Lambs will be either ewe or mutton lambs.

Fat pigs can either be gilts or barrows. They must come within a weight limit of from 175 to 300 pounds. Those coming below or over this weight will be disqualified and not allowed to be shown.

Entries of fat steers, fat lambs and fat pigs are limited to boys and girls from Eastland and adjoining counties. However, only the Eastland County animals can sell at the auction.

Farm Bureau To Open Full-Time Office In County

The Eastland County Farm Bureau has announced plans for a full-time office of the bureau to be opened by March 4, it was reported here. The tentative date for opening was set at a meeting of the board of directors of the organization recently. Ray Norris, Don Kincaid and Ben Freeman were appointed as a committee to make a survey of office space and to accommodate the office and a meeting room for the directors.

President Mitchell Campbell stated that the bureau has realized this need for some time and started the definite move recently when the dues were raised from \$8 to \$10. The extra \$2 provides a fund for this purpose. The board of directors will meet February 28 to hear the recommendations of the committee for a building and to name the secretary for the office.

Reserve Acreage Open To Grazing

The United States Department of Agriculture, Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation office has announced that the regulations have been changed to permit grazing of acreage signed up in 1957 in the Conservation Reserve, according to a report by Emmett E. Powell, county office manager.

This regulation permits grazing until April 15 or until the beginning of establishment of cover crop, which ever is earlier, and applies only to the land which has been placed in five year contracts. It does not apply to cotton or wheat reserve contracts in 1957 nor to Conservation Reserve Contracts beginning in 1956, according to Powell.

A resolution in memory of Dr. William P. Lee, beloved Cisco physician, was unanimously adopted by a rising vote in the Texas House of Representatives on January 31, according to a report here this week. Paul Brashers, representative from this district, offered the resolution, which follows:

"Whereas, the City of Cisco and the State of Texas lost an esteemed citizen with the passing of Dr. William P. Lee on Thursday, December 29, 1956; and

"Whereas, Dr. Lee was born in White Springs, Georgia, on October 26, 1861, and came to Stephens County, Texas, in 1880. In 1881 he helped in laying the Southern Pacific Railway through this section; and

"Whereas, Dr. Lee was farmer, rancher and school teacher when he decided to study medicine and enrolled at Vanderbilt University in Nashville, Tennessee, and graduated from Tulane in 1890, coming back to Breckenridge to begin his practice and where he married Miss May Ewing, moving to Cisco in 1894; and

"Whereas, Dr. Lee delivered over 5,000 babies, the births being recorded in ledgers dating back to his graduation from Tulane in 1890; and

"Whereas, he was a member of the First Presbyterian Church, having donated the land on which it is built, a member of the Masonic Lodge, was City Health Officer from 1932 until February, 1956; and

"Whereas, he is survived by two sons, Fielding Lee of Colorado City and Dudley Lee of Abilene, two daughters, Miss Theresa Lee of San Antonio and Miss Sara Lee of Baton Rouge, Louisiana, and one sister, Mrs. Will Lee of Hamlin; and

"Whereas, the House of Representatives wishes to pay tribute and express its sincere sympathy to his family with a copy of this resolution; now, therefore be it

"Resolved, that a page be set aside in the House Journal in his memory and that when the House adjourns this day it do so in loving respect to him."

Sombbrero Tamales— Quick and Flavorful Oven Dish

Really fine eating, partner, is this wonderfully delicious casserole of satisfying food which all the "cow punchers" in your family will praise and praise.

This quick oven dish is put together in a matter of minutes. It is almost an "out-of-the-can affair" because the rice cooks while you get out the cheese, the tamales and chili con carne and light the oven. This "savory favorite" from the southwest is different enough to make a big hit with company, too, and you'll find you won't need to "lasso" any compliments for it.

INGREDIENTS:

1—15 ounce can or jar of tamales and sauce

3 cups cooked rice

1—15½ ounce can chili con carne with beans

¾ cup water

¼ lb. American cheese, sliced

PREPARING THE FLUFFY WHITE RICE: To make 3 heaping cups of white, fluffy, perfectly cooked rice:

1. Put 1 cup uncooked rice, 2 cups of cold water and 1 teaspoon of salt into a 2-quart saucepan and bring to a vigorous boil.

2. Turn the heat as low as possible. Cover the saucepan with a lid. Do not remove lid nor stir rice while it is cooking.

3. Leave saucepan over this low heat for 14 minutes. Remove from the heat. The rice is now ready to use.

For extra fluffy, tender, separate grains allow the rice to steam for an additional 10 minutes— with heat off, but without removing lid.

For extra convenience and economy of time and effort, cook 2 cups of rice, 4 cups of water and 2 teaspoons of salt—keeping the extra cups of unused ready-cooked rice in the refrigerator in a covered container.

Use this rice as needed in quick, delicious and inexpensive soups, salads, casserole dishes, hot breads and desserts.

METHOD: Place the tamales and sauce in the bottom of a greased 2-quart baking dish. Top with the cooked rice. Pour the chili con carne over the rice.

Add the water. Place the cheese slices over the top of the chili con carne. Place in a 350°F. oven for 30 minutes or until the cheese has melted and the tamales, rice and chili con carne mixture is heated through.

If desired, save out three of the tamales and arrange them on the top of the cheese in the shape of a sombrero. Do this about 10 minutes before the cooking time is over in order that these tamales may become hot.

This recipe makes 8 servings.

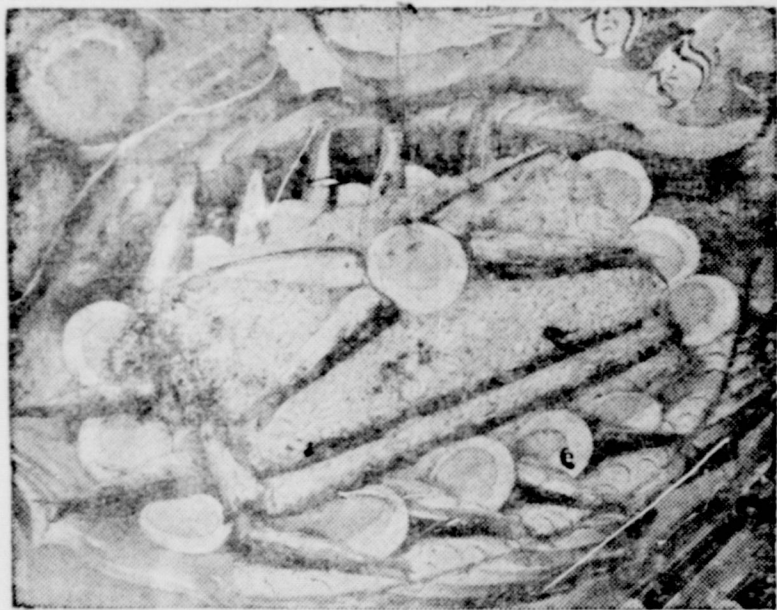

1/4 teaspoon pepper
3 cups milk
1/4 cup grated cheese

PREPARING THE FLUFFY WHITE RICE: To make 3 liberal cups of fluffy rice; put 1 cup uncooked rice, 2 cups of cold water and 1 teaspoon of salt in a two-quart saucepan and cover with a tight-fitting lid. Bring to a vigorous boil and then turn the heat as low as possible—leave over this low heat for 14 minutes. Turn off the heat. This cooking time results in firm grains of cooked rice. For extra tender grains, allow the rice to steam—with the heat off—for an additional 5 minutes before removing the lid.

Never remove lid nor stir rice while it is cooking. After rice is cooked, remove lid, lift gently with fork to allow rice to steam dry to the desired consistency.

It is then ready—perfectly cooked—with all the grains separate and fluffy. This method allows all the water to be absorbed and the full nutritional value of the rice to be retained.

METHOD: Thoroughly grease a 9 1/4" x 5 1/4" x 3 1/4" oven-proof loaf pan with a thick coating of melted butter or margarine. Mix the rice, milk and cheese. Place 1/2 of this rice mixture in the bottom of the pan and firmly press with a spoon. Lay 1/2 of the sardines on top of the rice layer. Add 1/2 of the rice mixture. Top with the second 1/2 of the sardines. Press the last of the rice over the sardines. Reserve the last 1/2 of the sardines to garnish the loaf.

Place the loaf pan in a 350° F. oven and bake 20 minutes. To unmold, run a knife around the edge of the pan to loosen the loaf. Place a platter over the pan. Invert the platter and pan together. Gently lift loaf pan up from the platter.

Serve with the cheese sauce which may be placed in an individual serving dish or may be served over the loaf. Garnish by arranging egg slices and the last 1/2 of the sardines over the top of the loaf and on the platter around the loaf. This recipe makes 7 servings.

METHOD FOR MAKING CHEESE SAUCE:

Over a low heat, melt butter, stir in flour and blend thoroughly. Allow to cook 4 or 5 minutes, stirring constantly to prevent browning. Add salt and pepper. Gradually add milk. Continue stirring and cook until mixture thickens. Add cheese and continue stirring until cheese has melted.
