Many Entries Are Expected In Pecan, Bake Shows This Week

All residents of Eastland County and adjoining counties will be eligible to enter products in the Pecan Bake Show to be held in connection with the annual Eastland County Pecan Show on December 14 and 15, according to an announcement by Mrs. Minnie Mae Hart, county home demonstration agent. The Bake Show will be held in the Reynolds Building in Cisco, sponsored by the County Home Demonstration Council.

Cakes, pies, or candy may be entered in the show. A whole cake or pie or six pieces of candy will be required to enter. All entries must contain pecans and must be entered by 11 a. m., December 14, Mrs. Hart stated.

The cakes, pies, and candy will be judged by the use of score cards. Cash prizes will be \$3.00 for first place, \$2.50 for second place, and \$1.50 for third place in all divisions. Ribbons will also be awarded. A grand prize of \$5.00 will be awarded in the cake division.

Entries will become the property of the bake show and will be sold with the proceeds to the Eastland County Home Demonstration Council. Entries will remain on display until 5 p. m. on Dec. 15.

Mrs. Hart urged Ciscoans to participate in this bake show and to visit on the two days that it is to be held.

The Pecan Show is due to attract a large number of area residents. All pecan growers in Eastland County and surrounding counties are eligible to enter nuts in the contest.

Entries in the Pecan Show should be made at the County Agent's office in Eastland or the Cisco Chamber of Commerce prior to the show. The nuts will be judged by a team from Texas A&M College, and will be returned to the owners. The blue-ribbon winners will be sent to the state pecan show at A&M.

Highlights of the show will be the crowning of the pecan queen in ceremonies at the Cisco Junior College Auditorium on Friday, December 14. Candidates are Marilyn Preston, Cisco; Mary Tonne, Nimrod; Rose Mary Berry, Pleasant Hill; Betty Yancey, Cheaney; and Carol Sue Tidwell, Desdemona.

Many Texans Join Military Service During October

AUSTIN, Tex. — A total of 4,126 Texan men joined the armed forces during October, and 3,850 were separated from active service during the same time. This was revealed Thursday in a report made by Colonel Morris S. Schwartz, state Selective Service director, to national Selective Service headquarters in Washington, D. C.

Of the 4,126 entries into the uniformed services from Texas during October, only 848 were through the draft boards, the remaining 3,278 individuals going into uniform by enlistment or other voluntary means.

State Selective Service forwarded 1,343 men to armed forces joint examining and induction stations during October for pre-induction physical and mental examinations. Of this number, 829 were found acceptable, the remaining 514 unacceptable, a rejection rate of approximately 38 per cent.

Of the 848 men inducted through the draft boards in October, six were inducted from the Texas National Guard upon certification that they had failed to serve satisfactorily. This is authorized by Section 1631.8 of the Selective Service regulations.

During October, under provisions of the doctor's draft law, 12 Texas physicians were inducted and found acceptable.

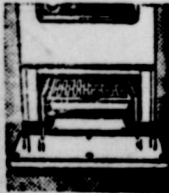
