How Many Cups in A Can?



TRANSLATING cans into cups is a thrifty measure, and a great convenience, if you desire to have a little bit of this and a little bit of that left over for one and one-third cups of tomatoes. It is thrifty to buy a No. 1 can which contains this exact amount; or if the recipe calls for two and one-third cups of tomatoes you can open a No. 2 can, confident that there will not be a spoonful left over.

But since few people can even remember how many gills in a table spoon or the whole table spoon from the beginning, it would be useless to try to remember cans and cupfuls. Just post this list in your kitchen, or place it inside the cover of your favorite recipe book for reference.

No. 2	1 lb. 3 oz.	2 1/3
No. 2 1/2	1 lb. 12 oz.	3 1/3
No. 3	2 lbs. 1 oz.	4

No. 10	6 lbs. 7 oz.	13

It is helpful, also, to know that a No. 2 1/2 can of peaches or pears contains from 12 to 15 halves. Apples vary widely in the number of halves; a Fancy can may contain 24 small halves; a Standard can usually contains 48 smaller halves.

DEATH BARES TRUE ENOCH ARDEN TALE
Remove Slits Shows how man was found by a Derelict.

San Francisco.—A tattoo mark on his arm and a mole on his shoulder had enriched John W. Davis, Johns stone cutter, \$10,000. His father, Barney McCabe, who died last October, willed his entire estate to his "lost son," who he said could be identified by the marks on his arm and shoulder.

By using airplanes the globe trotter can make the journey in about one-third the ordinary trip of Jules Verne. The new belt line follows roughly the route blazed by Gatty and Post instead of the beaten path via the Mediterranean, Suez canal, and India.

The short cut across the United States and spans the Pacific ocean from Seattle to Japan. Keeping well to the north Siberia is crossed by train, reversing the famous journey made by Marco Polo in 1293. The new route crosses Russia and from Moscow and landing the globe trotter proceeds by the shortest route to Sweden. On the theory that a straight line is the shortest distance between two points the traveler sails from Gothenburg and skirts the northern cape of Scotland on the direct route to New York. The new belt line reduces the trip from about 25,000 to 15,000 miles.

Bad Cooking and Crime
We have seen it written a good many times that bad cooking was at the bottom of a large portion of the world's crime; and we have never found any reliable statistics to support the claim. Why don't the habitable researchers and surveyors go about among our criminals and delinquents and ask them how the cooking was in their homes? Personally we think, and have often said, that this would be a better world if there were more good apple pie than there is, but we cannot prove even that.—Boston Herald.

Early Fermented Beverages
Dr. Harvey W. Hays says that wine is the most important of fermented beverages. He says: "It could be an early discovery, because some of the best wine is crushed and left to natural forces, undergo the alcoholic fermentation. Primitive man must, therefore, have been acquainted with the properties of the fermented juice of fruits, especially of grapes. Wine was known in the remotest historical times, as evidenced by reference to it in the oldest preserved literature."

New York.—"Thomas Bernsten, sixty years old, no home, found dead at 391 Hamilton avenue. Heart disease and exposure."
This promiscuous report wrote him to the case as far as the police were concerned, but from two of the dead man's friends, Thomas Bernsten was robbed in the home of Tompkinson's immortal Enoch Arden in a real life drama.

Bernsten, a Norwegian seaman, who sailed in the "Argo," before storm crowded canvas off the ocean highways, died a few days after turning from his home when he found his wife married to another man.

It was eight years' absence, coupled with the report of his death in a shipwreck that broke his home ties.

As John Olsen, superintendent of a Norwegian mill on Long Island, and friend of Bernsten, tells the story, the Norwegian sailed with 17 others on the full-rigger "Argo" in 1896. After a few months' cruise among ports in the South Sea, the vessel struck a reef and was wrecked. The crew took to a lifeboat, taking along a cat, their mascot, and two kites.

For two months they drifted without food or fresh water, except for precious drops collected during showers. The captain and the sailors went mad. They tried to kill the others. They later hung them overboard.

The others finally reached a small island. After a day there, during which they died from fever, they were picked up and taken to Sydney, Australia.

Not until eight years after the shipwreck did Bernsten finally get back home in Norway. He and his wife went to another man. Bernsten left without revealing his identity. He turned to the sea again until his age prevented him from sailing before the mast.

Unrecognized and suffering from a heart ailment, Bernsten died a derelict.
Infants Paralytic
"Byron, who had his feet possibly resulting from infantile paralysis, or poliomyelitis as the doctors call it, was a fond of athletics and found that his handicap did not apply when he was in the water. From constant exercise he was able to become so strong that he eventually was able to swim the Hellemont just as a delinquent in the golden days of Greece." Dr. John Hubbard told readers of "Ligeia" Magazine in his article entitled "Polo."

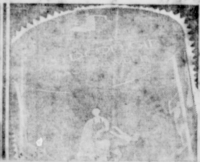
