News From Our County Agent

Approximately over half of the counties in Texas are now brucellosis free areas or in the process of getting their counties in line for the brucellosis program, says county agent Flip Breedlove. Mr. Spencer Sitter, rancher in the northeast part of Donley County, is chairman of the animal health committee for Donley County and says that petitions are now in the communities in the hands of committeemen signing up ranchers and stock men who favor the brucellosis program for Donley County. It will take seventy-five percent of all stock owners in the county, representing fifty one percent of the cattle before the program can go into effect for Donley County.

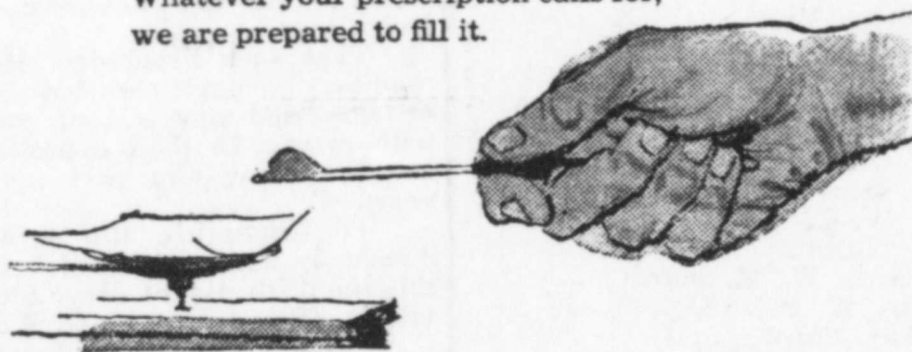

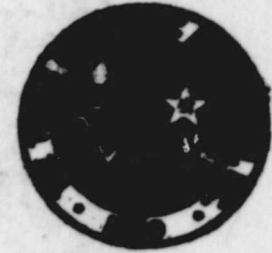

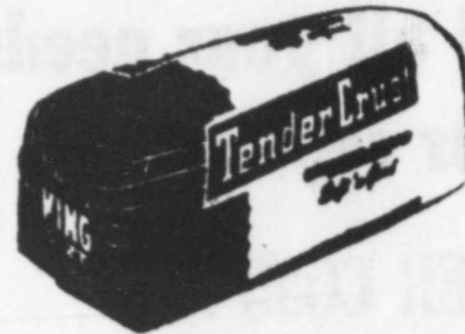
