Agriculture Clinic

The annual Agriculture Clinic for Donley County will be held on April 16 in the community room of the Farmers State Bank at Clarendon, according to an announcement by County Agent H. M. Breedlove. He states that the program will start promptly at 9 a. m. and that each part of the program will start exactly as shown on the program.

Times and topics are:

9 to 10, the 1964 wheat program
10 to 11, Fertilizers and their use.

11 to 12, Grain sorghums, varieties for this area.

1:15 to 2:15, Insect control of wheat, cotton and grain sorghums

2:15 to 3:15, Feed lot experiments, starting feed lots and protein supplements for range cows.

3:15 to 4 Range management of native grasses, adapted varieties and planting.

Everyone is urged to attend this clinic.

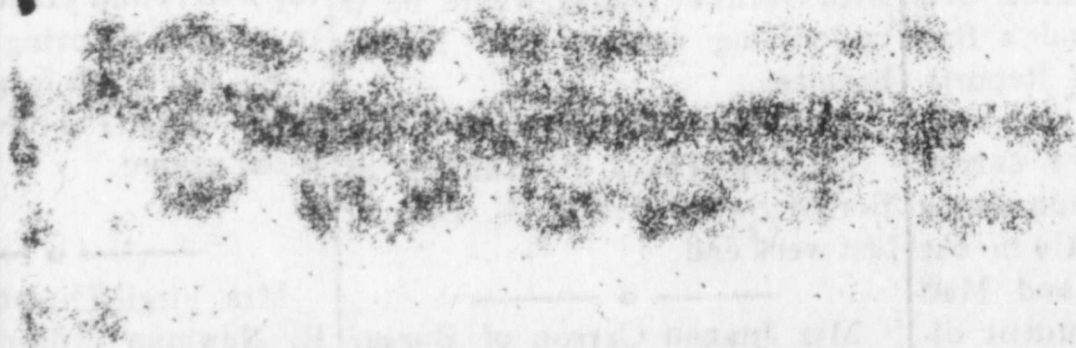

Feed Grain Sign-Up Closes

As of the closing date, March 22, farmers in Donley County had signed up 278 farms to participate in the 1963 feed grain program. The "intention to participate" forms show 10,238 acres to be diverted from the production of corn, grain sorghum, and barley. The diversion is from base acreages of 31,834 acres.

For farms signed up, estimated total payments for diverting acreage amount to \$77,902 00, not including price support payments to be made this fall.

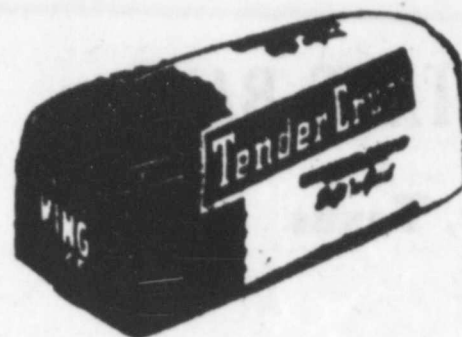
