It is with universal regret the citizens of Brady learn of the contemplated removal from the city of Mr. and Mrs. L. A. Williams and family. The change in locations is the result of Mr. Williams' promotion by the Bowman Lumber Co. to the management of the company yards at Paris, Texas. Paris is a city of some 30,000 or more inhabitants, and since the great fire of two years ago has been almost entirely rebuilt along most modern and approved lines. It is backed up by a thickly settled country, which contributes greatly to the success of the lumber industry as evidenced by the fact that there are 25 yards in Paris. Crops have been very good there too, some farmers making 30 bushels of wheat and some as high as 100 bushels of oats. Mr. Williams formerly was

in Paris, leaving there in 1901; consequently, while he and his family regret to sever the many pleasant ties that bind them to Brady, they feel like they are going back among old friends and acquaintances.  
During the ten years or more Mr. and Mrs. Williams have resided in Brady, they have made themselves popular members of business, social and religious circles. Mr. Williams has been actively interested in the welfare and upbuilding of Brady, and the confidence of the citizens have reposed in him is evidenced by his selection as a councilman for successive terms, he being at present a member of that body.  
A. F. Larner of Jacksboro will succeed Mr. Williams as local manager, and he is expected to arrive in the city Friday morning. Mr. Larner has been with the Bowman people a number of

years and is regarded as one of their most efficient men.  
Mr. Williams and family expect to complete their preparations for leaving by the first of next week, and the good wishes of all their friends will accompany them to their new home.

**SCHOOL LANDS.**  
**Will Not Be Forfeited for Non-Payment of Interest.**  
County Clerk W. J. Yantis is in receipt of advice from J. T. Robison of Austin, commissioner of the General Land office of the State of Texas, asking that publicity be given his decision not to forfeit school lands because of non-payment of the current year's interest. We quote from the letter as follows:  
"On account of conditions resulting from an unprecedented drought throughout the school land territory, I have concluded not to forfeit lands on August 15th this year for the non-payment of interest due to November 1st, 1916; that is, where persons are due one year's interest up to last November, I will not forfeit, but where in-

terest is due for 1915, it should be paid."

**Helping Solve Car Shortage.**

The Santa Fe Railway helped solve the car shortage problem by purchasing 3,800 new freight cars, which will be delivered during August, September and October. The lot includes 1,500 coal cars, 1,000 stock cars, 800 refrigerator cars and 500 tank cars. The company also purchased 130 locomotives, 30 to be delivered in August, 35 before January 1, 1918, and 65 in 1918.

The purchase price of the 3,800 cars is \$8,910,000. Tank cars in large lots now cost \$2,800 a piece, as against \$1,255 in 1915, when the Santa Fe made a heavy investment in this line of equipment. Coal cars now cost \$2,500, as against \$1,283 in 1913; refrigerator cars, \$2,200, as against \$1,449 in 1916, and stock cars \$2,000, as against \$1,089 in 1916.

The purchase price of the 130 locomotives is \$6,500,000, or \$50,000 a piece. In 1916 the Santa Fe bought the same type of locomotives for \$33,767 a piece.

The total cost of new locomotives and cars for the Santa Fe at this time, including 25 baggage cars and 10 passenger coaches is \$15,852,880. The passenger coaches now cost \$20,538 as against \$16,152 in 1914, and the baggage cars, \$13,500 as against \$10,287, same year.

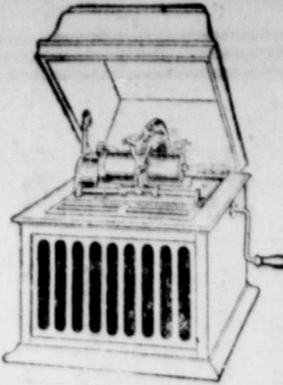
