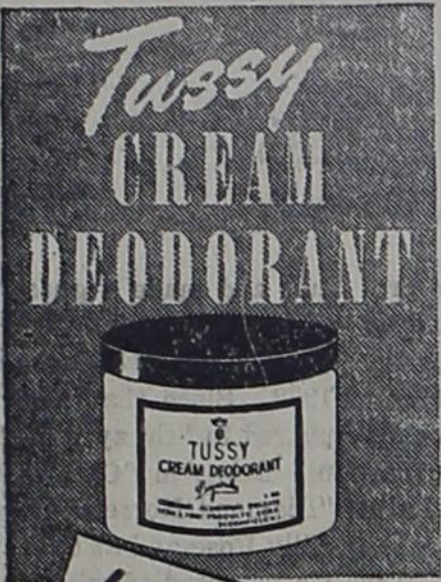

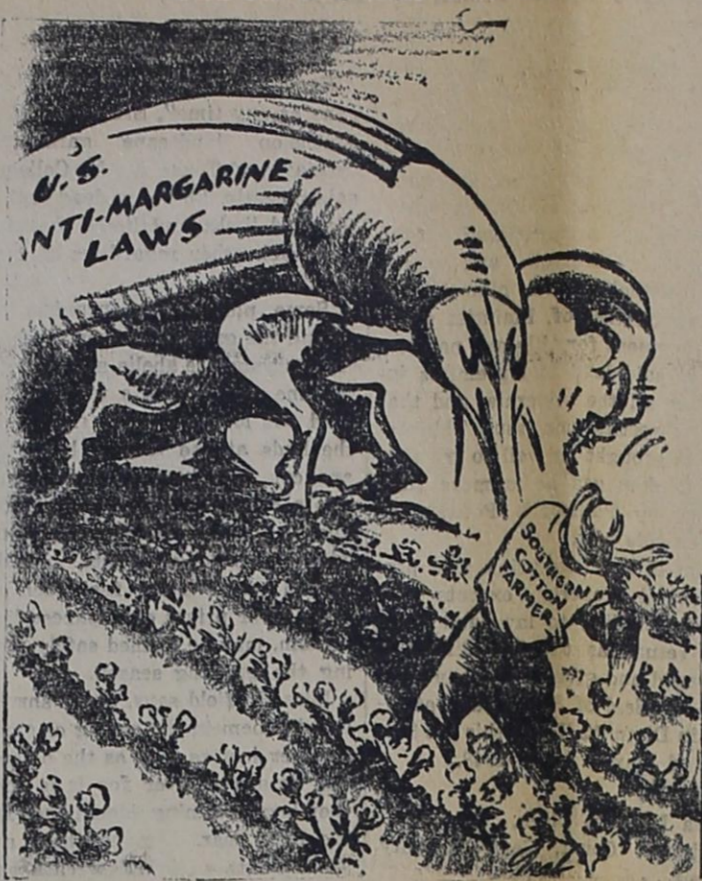

**Social Security
Tax Returns Due**

It's time for employers to file their quarterly social security tax returns again—but the Social Security Administration doesn't want your money! J. R. Sanderson, manager of the Amarillo, Texas Social Security Office, says that his office again has received a number of tax returns, with money enclosed, which should have been sent instead to the Collector of Internal Revenue.

When mailed, the quarterly social security tax returns should be sent to the Collector of Internal Revenue, Dallas, Texas.

When sent by error to the social security office, returns are delayed in reaching Internal Revenue, Sanderson explained.

He reminded employers who have not yet completed the returns for the quarter ending March 31, 1948, that they should exercise care in reporting the complete name and exact social security account number of each employee who worked, for no matter how short a period, during January, February, and March. The return must be filed not later than April 30, 1948, by all employers of one or more persons on work covered by Social Security.

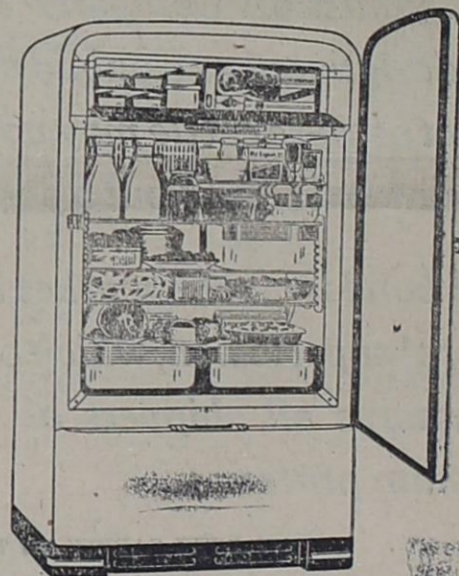

TRIM YOUR TREES—

Some kinds of pruning may be done at any time", Sadie Hatfield, extension landscape gardening specialist of Texas A. M. College, said recently. "Remove dead limbs, diseased limbs and limbs that injure each other regardless of season."

Some plants need pruning all during the growing season. Among these shrubs are abelia and Florida jasmine which have a tendency to send out long awkward shoots. If the buds at the tips of branches are cut off the plant will grow into a compact form which generally is liked better than a shrub with a few long sprouts. Hardy shrubs which grow fast such as amur river privet or Japanese ligustrum, may be pruned safely during the growing season.

Miss Hatfield says, prune shrubs which bloom in the spring or early summer just as soon as the blooming season is over for it is then they begin forming bloom buds for the next year. Among these are such plants as bridal wreath and flowering peach. If you wait until late summer or winter, pruning lessens the amount of blooms as it destroys bloom buds.

Among flowering shrubs to be pruned as soon as they have bloomed and before they form bloom buds for the next year's flowers are:

Azaleas, butterfly bush (buddleia), redbud, flowering quince, flowering dogwood, catanaster, poinsettia, philadelphus (English dogwood, mock orange) photinia, flowering plums, spreas, viburnums (haws and snowballs), primrose, jasmine, winter blooming jasmine, and wisteria.

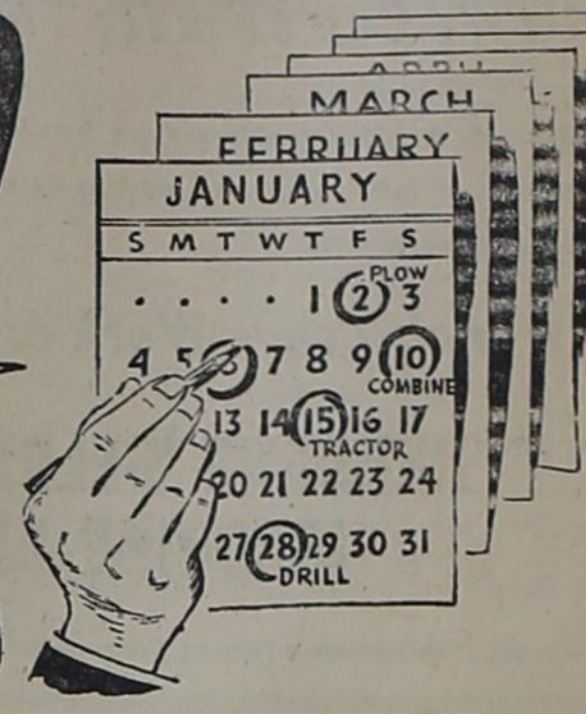

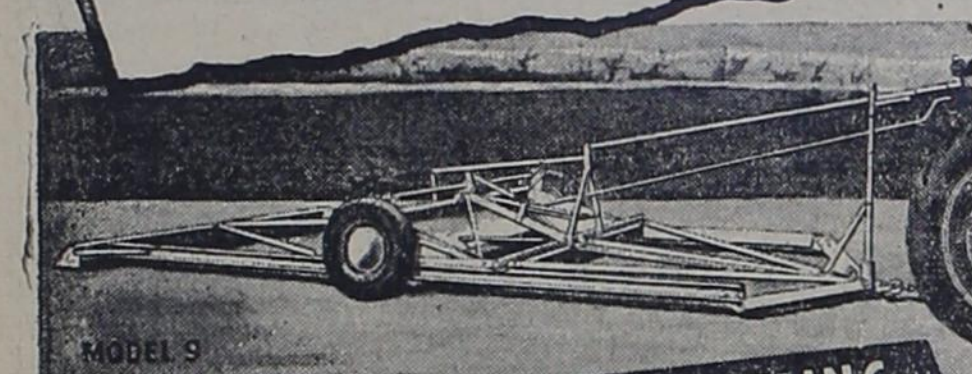
