Public Notice

The results of the coliform bacteriological samples exceeded the Texas Department of Health's "Drinking Water Standards," which were promulgated as required by the "Safe Drinking Water Act." Public Law 93-523. Drinking water containing coliform bacteria in excess of the standard may constitute a potential threat to public health. Your water system has collected additional check samples as required by the "drinking water standards," and in the final check report no Coliform Count was found. The presence of coliform organisms in water is an indicator of bacteriological contamination of the sample either from the water system or from a sampling error.
