Same as Nominated. A. M. Dockery was in Kansas City for dinner last night, but sped on to his home at Gallatin breathing deep, deep breaths and carrying his hat tipped knowingly over his right eye.

With Sam Cook, Ed. Orear and Virgil Conking, Mr. Dockery had been to the Clay county convention. He had heard the delegates to the State convention instructed for him, and carried in his pocket telegrams from St. Francis, Morgan and two other counties, all telling of similar action.

That settled the candidate's chances and when he came to town yesterday evening it was to say with good feeling that he was officially nominated.

By the same votes so were Sam Cook for secretary of state and Crow for attorney general. The rest of the ticket is in doubt.

These three candidates have trained together, although they have not worked for each other.

St. Louis and Jackson counties have not yet elected their delegates, but it is known they will both be for the triumvirate, and the addition of those two strengths will merely add to the majority the three men will get in the convention.

It is supposed they will all be nominated by acclamation. Mr. Cook said last night that now that the nominating question had been settled there remained little to say of the results of the polls.

"We will be elected," he said with the assurance of all his democracy, "and Mr. Dockery's majority will be the largest a democrat has polled since the party assumed power in Missouri. He has been nominated, he will be elected, and he will give the state a clean-cut administration."
