### Bud Breen Show Scheduled For Sunday In Ozona

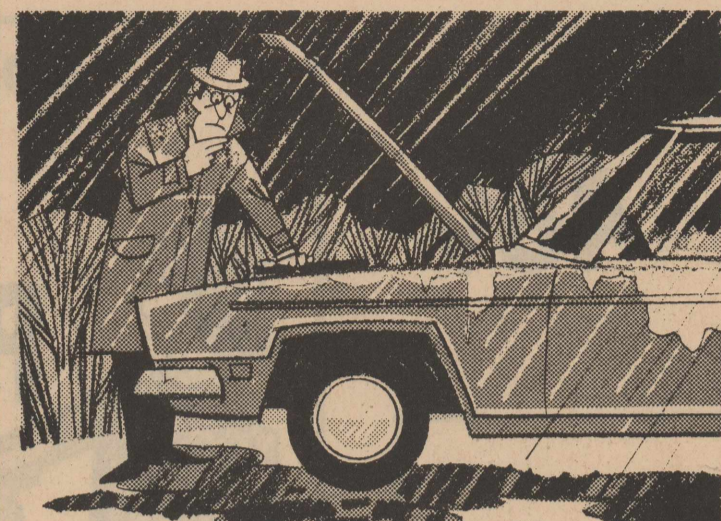

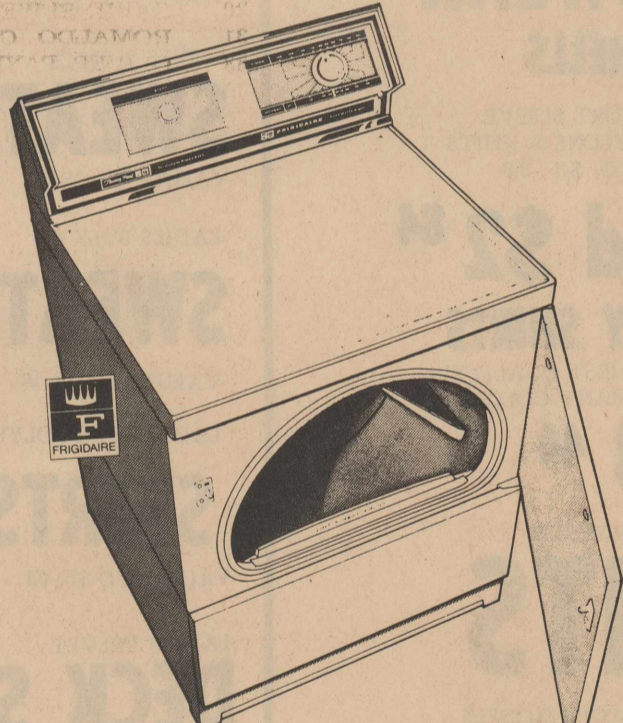


