MANY Democrats in this city are going to vote for Hon. Jerry Galvan. That's certain.

MEN are saying everywhere, "Give us the man who will work for West Texas, and we will vote for him, we don't care which party he belongs to."

THE CLOVEN FOOT is shown continually, and in every place by the Ku Klux Democracy. Any out-break against law and order, especially if it have the odor of hatred against the United States Government, is at once hailed by them throughout the country, with enthusiastic rejoicing, as a Democratic victory. So it happened in the little village of Pleasanton, Atascosa county, about thirty miles from San Antonio, on the reception of the rebellion in Louisiana. A public meeting was called, "and amid much enthusiasm," as we learn from the *Stock Journal*, adopted resolutions "congratulating" the insurgents, and condemning "any attempt of Mr. Grant's bayonets to over ride and subvert the sovereign will of the people of Louisiana!" Great goodness, what crazy nonsense Ku Klux Democracy will drive men to. Say the "sovereign will" of the desperadoes of DeWitt county, and be done with it.

The citizens of Uvalde County have held two Conventions within the last four days, the first a ratification meeting, endorsing the action of the Goliad Convention, and Gov. Coke's administration. Resolutions were passed repudiating the course of Gen. D. Y. Portis, who held the proxy for Uvalde County, for denouncing the administration in the District Convention. The second County Convention held last night by the friends of Gen. Portis, also endorsed the Goliad Convention and the Governor's administration, but deplored the action of the other meeting in condemning the action of Gen. Portis. There were but few in attendance and they were not enthusiastic.—*Stock Journal's letter from Uvalde.*

All this fight over Gov. Coke and General Portis in Uvalde is exceedingly amusing to "a man up a tree." Gen. Portis, in the Goliad Convention, in opposing the endorsement of Coke's administration, represented the real feelings of all his fellow-citizens except a few office holders and wire-workers. He even represented the real views of the *Stock Journal*. The first meeting in Uvalde was gotten up by two well known lawyers from San Antonio. Gen. Portis represents the people, and the tricksters are trying to hide the fact.

The Corrupt Bargain.
 The correspondent of the Cincinnati Gazette, from whom we have already quoted to show that McEnery was to resign, and allow Penn to be Governor, in Louisiana, says:
 The insurrection came. Penn was victorious, and McEnery was sent for on Wednesday to come and offer his resignation, thus completing his portion of the bargain. He was met while on his way from Vicksburg by a Committee from the White League, and the whole matter was talked over on the return in a Pullman coach, which was occupied by them exclusively, with the exception of two ladies, who had the state-room, and who overheard the greater part of the conversation.
 From one of these ladies I have the story. She says that after the congratulations upon the present victory and the outlook, one of the Committee began to allude to McEnery's part of the bargain, and he refused defiantly and utterly to perform it. He said that he had been supported in the struggle by men to whom he had promised office, and that they had furnished him funds with the understanding that he should put them in positions where they could make their contributions good. He did not re-

member having definitely agreed to any such contract, and he should not resign unless Penn allowed him to make all of the appointments, and agree to keep in office the men he named. In this decision, McEnery was supported by several of the Committee, and a very excited discussion ensued, after which McEnery agreed to let Penn hold the gubernatorial reins for the meantime until a compromise could be effected. McEnery arrived in the city and made a brief speech in response to his welcome, but was not seen thereafter. At no time during the day has he been at the head quarters of his faction, and he took no part in the consultation with General Ewing and others, although several orders were issued in his name.

SENATOR JONES arrived at his home in Gold Hill, Nevada, on August 25, and received a public welcome from the citizens, who turned out in force to receive him.

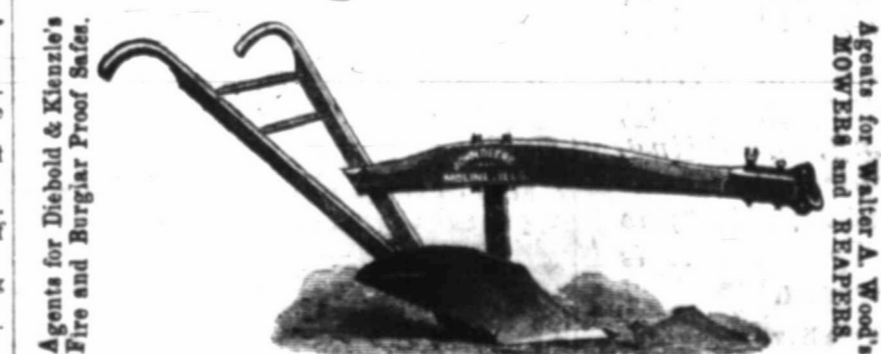

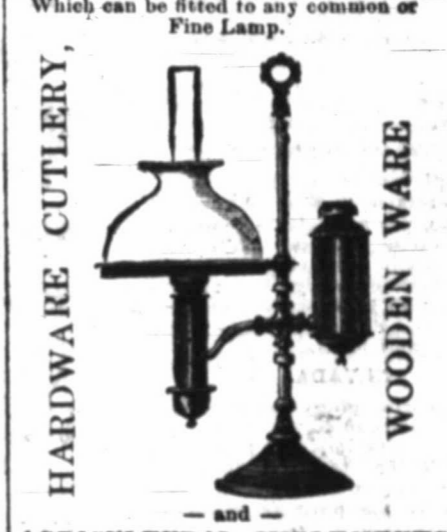
