**New Offer Rejected!** At Tuesday morning's Commissioners' Court meeting, the Commissioners rejected the third offer from 4C Cowboy Church for the old prison facility. The most recent offer from the Cowboy Church was for \$250,000. Several members of the public spoke in support of the county selling the property to the church. The property being permanently removed from the tax roll, due to the church's non-profit status, appeared to be the main objection offered by the court. It was noted that at the 2013 appraisal value of \$685,000, the county would receive less than \$6,000 per year in taxes from the property. Also noted by the public was the increased deterioration and downturn in the economy since the appraisal in 2013. Judge Blair addressed this point by saying the court hoped to sell the property to someone who would improve upon its current condition and the taxes would, therefore, increase. During the meeting, the church did not ask to be put on the agenda for the next Commissioners' Court to be held Tuesday, July 26, 2016.

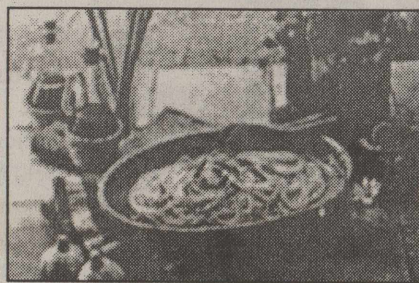

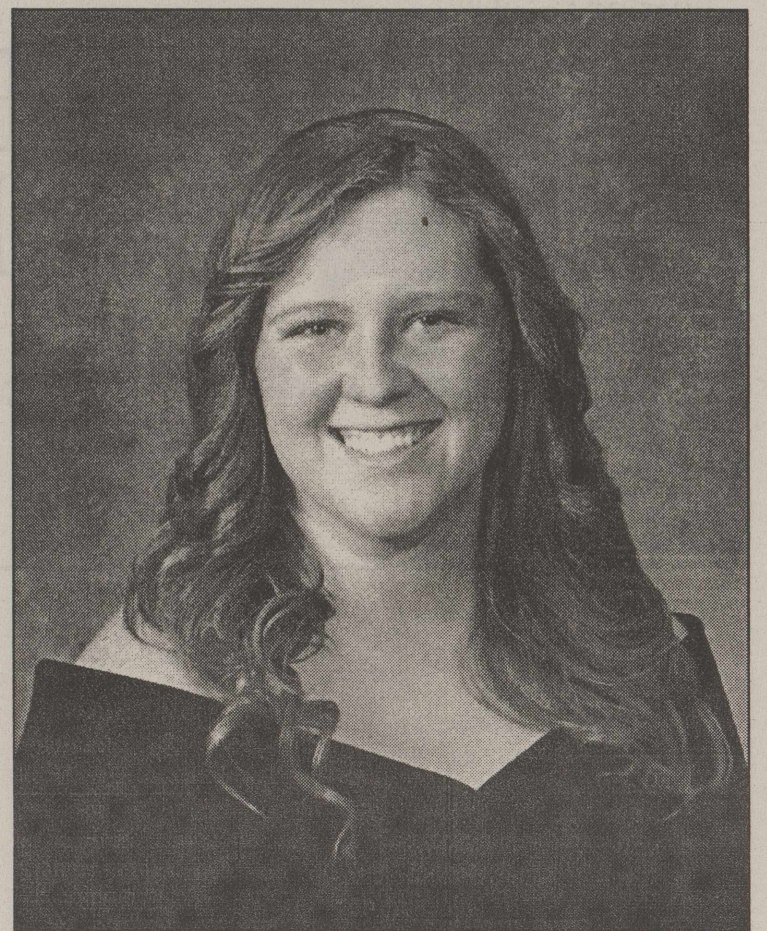

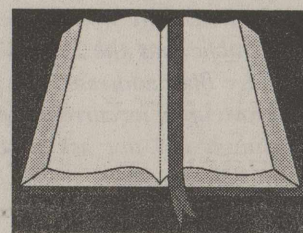

The Board approved accepting the bids received for

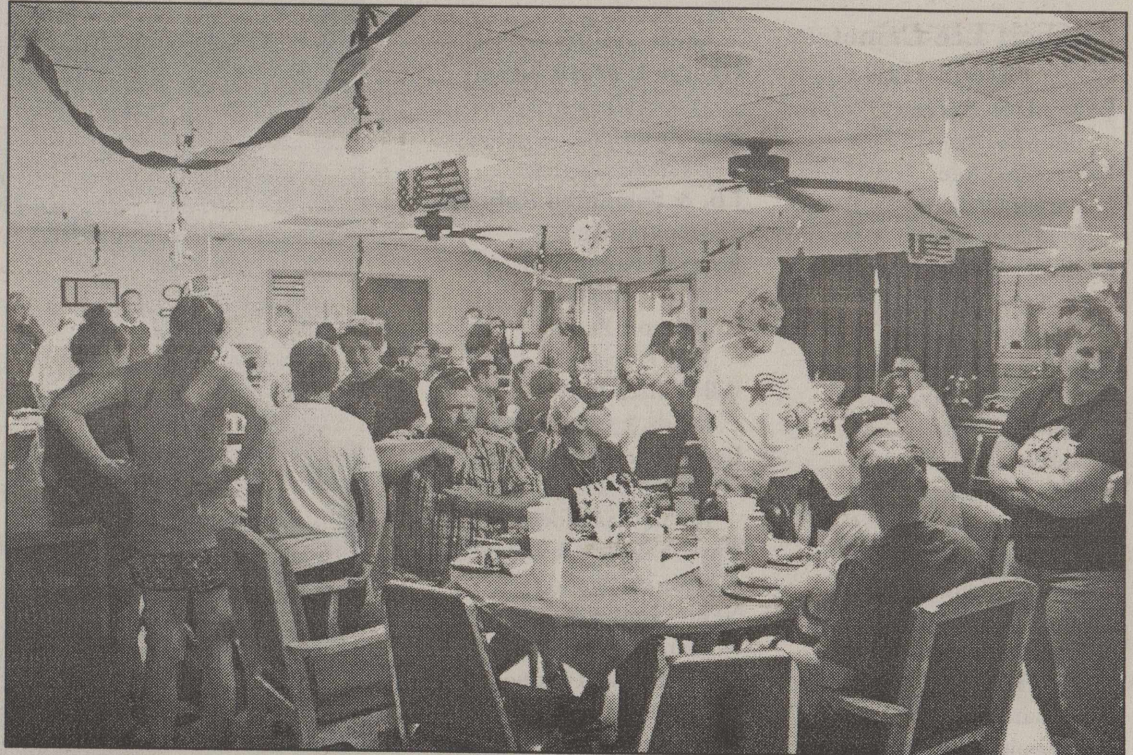
purchase of property in trust in Coke Co.
