The Robert Lee ISD Board of Directors met in regular session at 5 pm Tuesday, April 20, 2017. The meeting was called to order by President Washam.

Members present were Wes Washam, Jeffie Roberts, George Grim, Tom Sawyer, Irma Torres, Beverly Sinclair and Erin Oleksiuk.

Tom Sawyer gave the invocation and led the pledge.

George Grim made a motion to approve the minutes of March 28, 2017, and April 4, 2017, seconded by Tom Sawyer. All voted for.

Beverly Sinclair made a motion to approve the financial reports as presented by Robin Allen and to approve the bills, seconded by Jeffie Roberts. All voted for.

Supt. Hood gave the high school and elementary reports; enrollment for grades 7-12 was 107 and attendance rate was 95% for the month of March. Enrollment for elementary was 174 students and 95% attendance rate.

Supt. Hood recommended signing the agreement with Eligibility Tracking Calculators (ETC) for the 2017-2018 school year. Tom Sawyer made the motion to approve recommendation, seconded by Irma Torres. All voted for.

Supt. Hood recommended signing the Lease Renewal with Concho Valley Council of Governments for the 2017-2018 school year. George Grim made the motion to approve recommendation, seconded by Jeffie Roberts. All voted for.

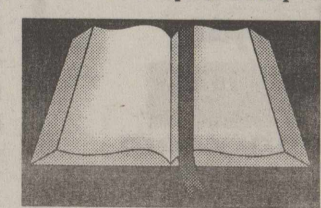

**Fort Chadbourne Gold Star Families Memorial Monument**

**Groundbreaking set for May 12**

On Friday, May 12, 2017, at 10:30 am, the Fort Chadbourne Foundation will be breaking ground on a Gold Star Families Memorial Monument to be erected at Fort Chadbourne later this year. WWII Medal of Honor recipient Hershel "Woody" Williams will be on hand to help with the groundbreaking.

The purpose of the Gold Star Families Memorial Monument is to honor Gold Star Families, preserve the memory of the fallen, and stand as a stark reminder that Freedom is not free. This stunning black granite monument features two sides. One side bears the words: Gold Star Families Memorial Monument, a tribute to Gold Star Mothers, Fathers, and Relatives who have sacrificed a Loved One for our Freedom. The other side tells a story through the four granite panels: Homeland, Family, Patriot, and Sacrifice. The scenes on each panel are a reflection of Gold Star Families and their fallen Heroes. At the center of this tribute is the most distinct feature of the monument, the 6'6" cut out of a saluting soldier representing the Loved One who paid the ultimate sacrifice in the name of Freedom.

The Hershel Woody Williams Medal of Honor Foundation was established a few years ago to work with other foundations and communities to place these monuments all across the United States. Fort Chadbourne wanted to be a part of such an honorable tribute and this will be the first one placed in the West Texas area. Once the monument is completed, a dedication will be held. It is tentatively set for this fall. A 2' replica of the monument is on display at Fort Chadbourne. At present, 19 monuments have been dedicated in 34 states and 43 memorial monuments are in progress.

The groundbreaking is open to the public and everyone is invited to attend the event, especially our Coke County Gold Star Families. This monument is for you. Admission to the groundbreaking is free. A reception will follow in the Fort Chadbourne Visitor Center/Museum.
