(d) If a polycart is lost or damaged by the resident, a \$70.00 replacement fee will be assessed.

H. CONTAINERIZED SANITATION SYSTEM:

1. After the effective date of this ordinance, certain public, business and/or commercial locations and sites shall receive sanitation container system service for the removal of garbage and trash under the rates and rules hereinafter set forth. A residential service may be allowed sanitation container system service on a short time basis. 
