## John Goree, 93, former citizen, dies at Graham

John L. Goree, 93, of Graham, and former citizen of Newcastle, passed away Friday at the General Hospital in Graham.

John Lynch Goree, one of the pioneer citizens of Newcastle, and a former coal miner, was born at Buckholts, Texas, September 1, 1872. He moved to the Newcastle area in 1909 and was a citizen of this community for many years before moving to Graham. He was favorably and widely known and the many friends will regret to hear of his passing. Goree was a member of the Assembly of God Church and a veteran of the Spanish American War.

Funeral services were held at 2:30 p. m. in the chapel of the Morrison Funeral Home with Rev. Vern Fuqua of Salem Methodist Church officiating. Burial was in the Pioneer Cemetery under direction of Morrison Funeral Home.

Survivors include his wife; five sons, Willie and Monroe of Roswell, N. M.; Cecil of Fort Worth, and J. L. Jr. and Clarence of Graham; two daughters, Mrs. Lillie Mae Walden, Roswell, N. M., and Mrs. Nell Bennett, Wichita Falls, Texas; one brother, Billy of Stamford, and one sister, Mrs. Annie Alley of San Angelo; nine grandchildren and 10 great-grandchildren.
