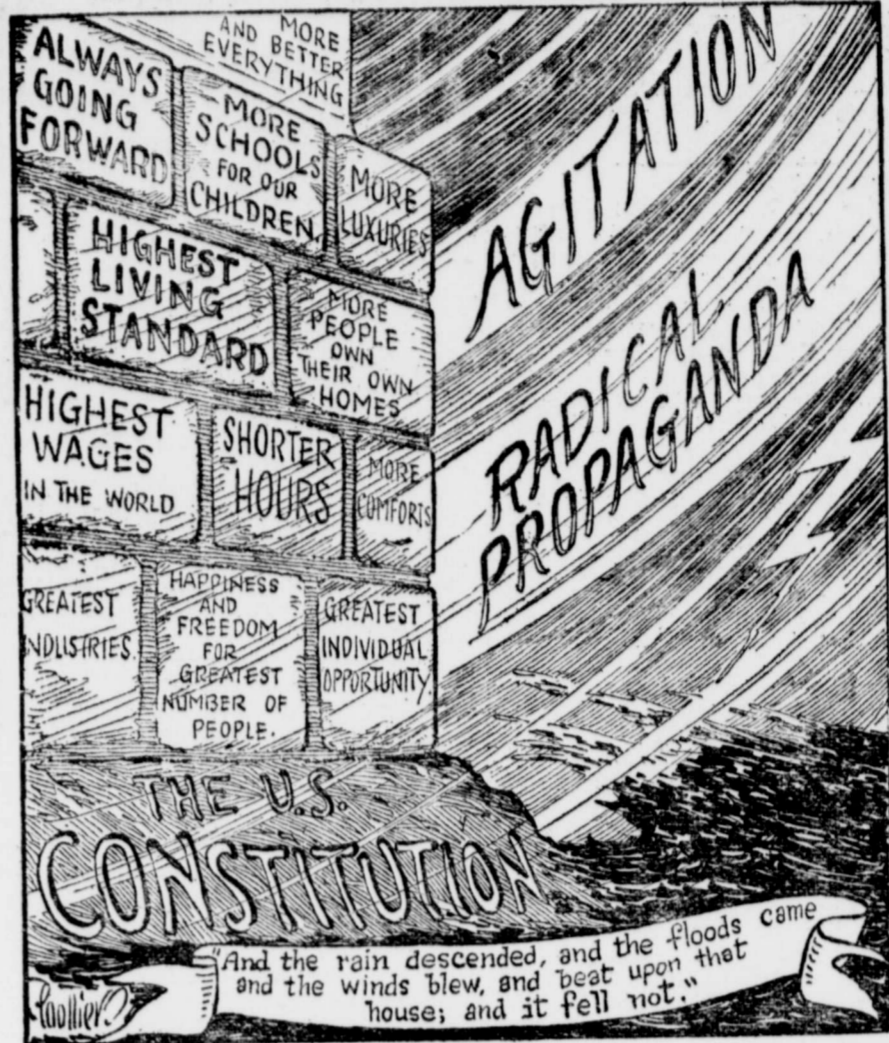

GILLILLAND NAMED NFLA HEAD IN MEETING HERE

More than 20 members of the Abernathy National Farm Loan Association and their friends heard Secretary-treasurer W. A. Richter & the board of directors of the association report on the association's progress during the past year at a meeting held at the high school auditorium, Jan. 11, 1938. Reports showed that this cooperative lending institution has made available to landowners in this community loans for more than \$1,176,960.00 since its organization in 1918. Other reports showed that many of the loans have been paid off, out of incomes from the farms.

W. A. Richter read a communication from A. C. Williams, President The Federal Land Bank and general agent of the Farm Credit administration of Houston, which outlined the work done by the Federal Land bank in 1937, and discussed briefly the set-up of National Farm loan associations and the essential factors to be considered in making farm mortgage loans.

Speakers at the meeting included F. W. Struve, Q. D. Halmark and G. G. Gilliland. Richter reported that G. G. Gilliland, N. A. Davis, E. G. Thompson Herman Schulz and Chris Benn were elected directors of the association, and that they in turn have elected G. G. Gilliland president of the association, E. G. Thompson, vice president and that W. A. Richter was re-elected secretary-treasurer.

In addition to the business transacted, a resolution was passed asking Hon. Geo. Mahon, Congressman from this district, to push the passage of the bill introduced in the last Congress, extending the time of payment of Commissioner's Loan over a longer period.

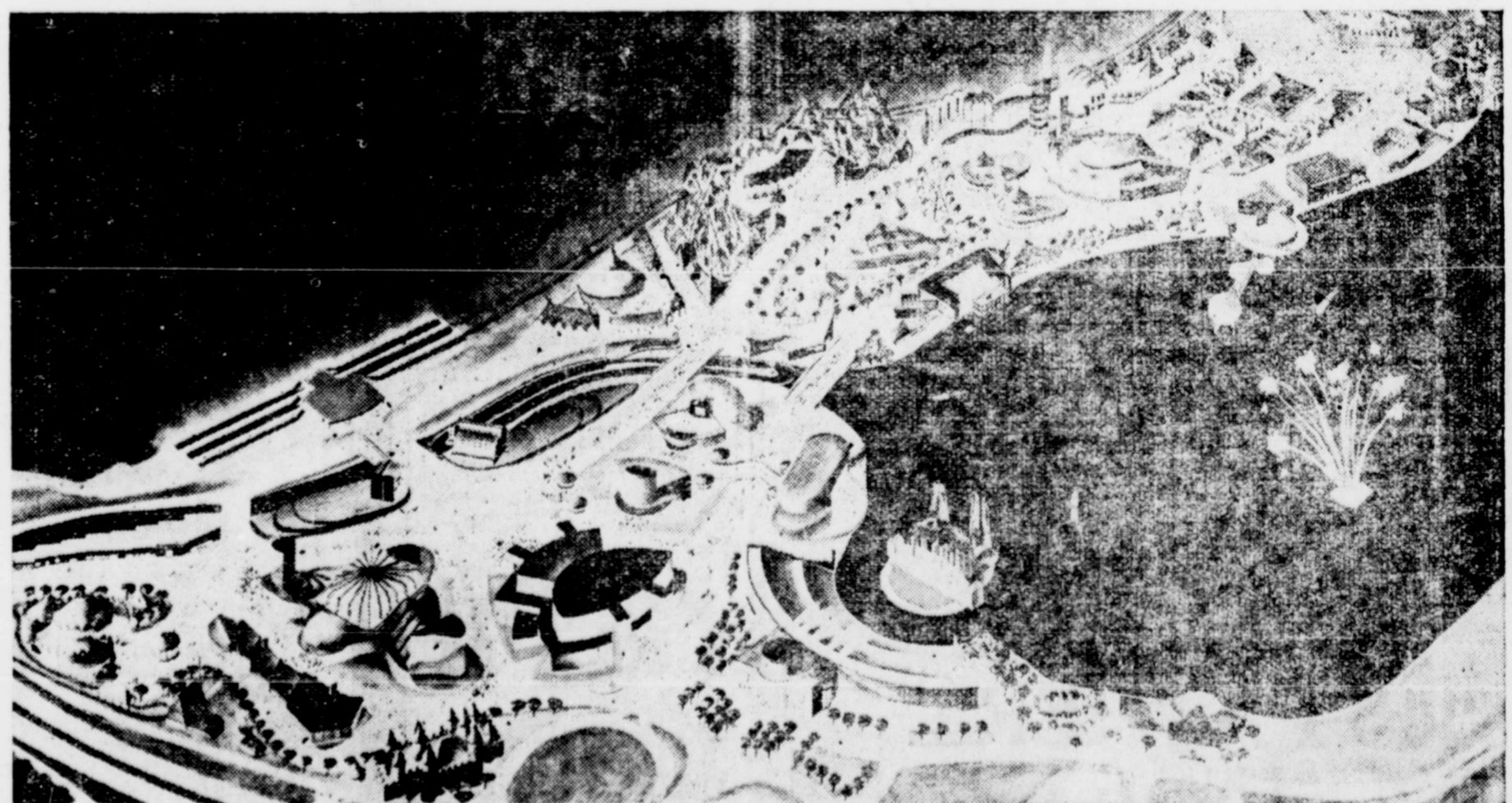
