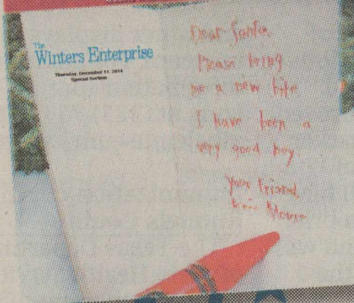

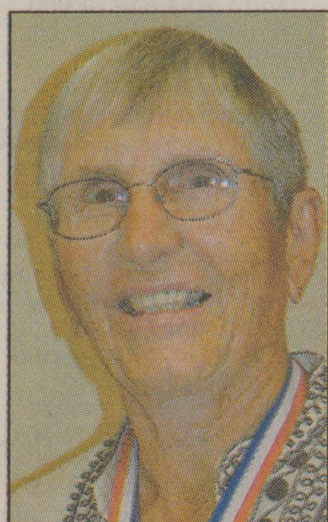

## Sally Buxkemper honored by TFB

CORPUS CHRISTI- Area cattle raiser Sarah "Sally" Buxkemper, an international leader in the beef industry and a strong promoter of agriculture in Runnels County, was honored by Texas Farm Bureau with its prestigious Pioneer Award at the organization's Annual Meeting in Corpus Christi.

"This award is designed to honor people like Sally who have helped form the foundation of Texas agriculture and Texas Farm Bureau," said TFB President Kenneth Dierschke. "We're proud to recognize Sally and the work she's done to pioneer the beef industry worldwide."

Buxkemper aided in the development of the Simbrah cattle, which is a combination of the Simmental and Brahman breeds. She was also one of the first women to graduate with an Animal Husbandry degree from Oklahoma State University.

Buxkemper joined Texas Farm Bureau in 1989 and has participated in events promoting both agriculture and Farm Bureau. She's served on the Runnels County Farm Bureau board of directors and has served on local committees as well as the state's Beef Cattle committee.

"We're thankful for the expertise and time Sally devoted to TFB and agriculture," Dierschke said.

Buxkemper is also a member of the Texas A&M Animal Science Advisory Council and the American Simmental Association.

She's also received the Beef Improvement Federation Pioneer Award and was honored by the State of Tabasco, Mexico for her leadership and support of the Simmental and Simbrah breeds.

Buxkemper was inducted into the Cowgirl Hall of Fame in 2011.

TFB's Pioneer Award honors one outstanding Texas farmer or rancher in each of the organization's 13 districts, as well as one staff member. Winners are chosen annually by a panel of their peers for their exceptional contributions to agriculture and Texas Farm Bureau.

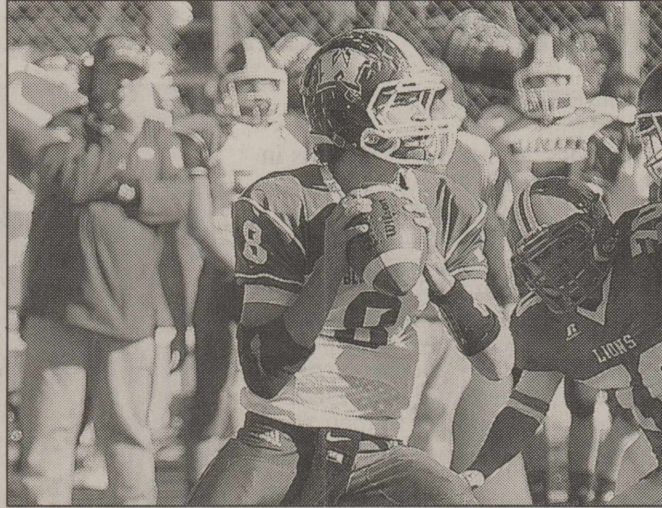

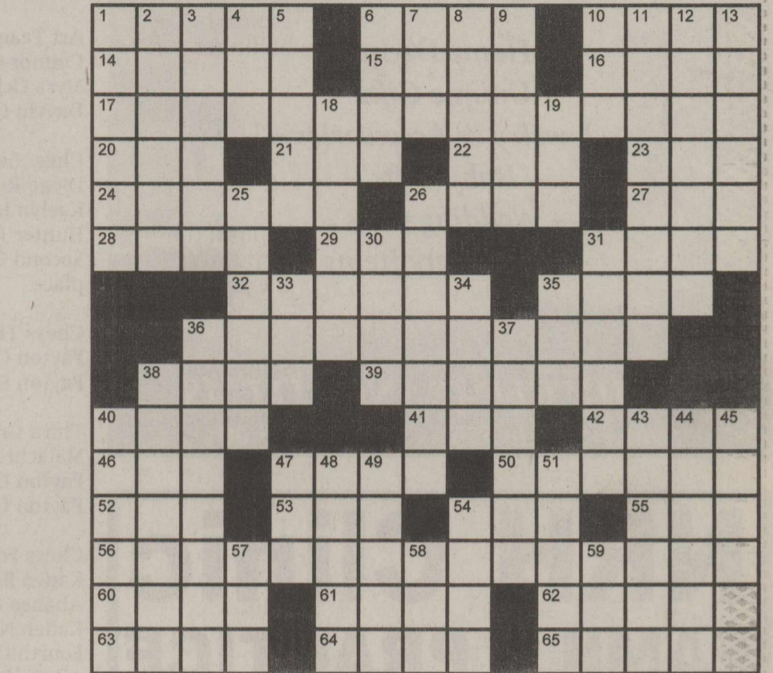

## Weather Whys

**Q:** Some days it's very breezy, and other days, there seems to be no wind at all. What causes wind?

**A:** There are several reasons why it's windy one day and calm the next, says Brent McRoberts of Texas A&M University. Wind is caused by air flowing from an area of higher pressure to an area of lower pressure, he explains. "Add to that the rotation of the Earth, which also affects air flow," he adds. "And during daylight hours, winds increase as sunlight heats the ground and causes convection to occur, meaning heat is moving away from the Earth's surface. At night, this convection dwindles and the winds die down. Nature is always trying to balance things out, and the result of trying to balance and equalize pressure from one area to another results in wind."
