I think the field of neuroscience might be thoroughly fascinating. I have noticed subtle realities concerning my own ability or method of thinking (or perhaps, about my own concerning method of thinking) – little indicators of when things are firing properly and when there are misfires. This is engine/gearhead jargon, yet it might also be the best literal choice for brain processes, insofar as neurons “fire” to communicate with

each other. I have noticed that if I am distracted in the slightest (as now), part of my brain remains unavailable to me, as it is preoccupied – I hesitate to say it is “dealing with” – those things which are capturing my attention in the background. Practically, this is why it is helpful to start a work day with a clean desk, or vehicle, or even just clean clothes. This is why it is helpful to start a morning with un-

cluttered countertops; why it is counterproductive to fire up the computer with unfinished business left on the desktop, or browser, or wherever, ready to smack you in the brain when you see it. And this is why it is disastrous to have as a general habit a bunch of unresolved things at the end of each day, consuming cognitive bandwidth prior to and during the time when rest and sleep are needed. This is why so many seem-

ingly-unrelated things are connected – like having an orderly environment insofar as that is possible; having a chance for quiet to offset the perpetual noise of life; and having space, opportunity, and the habit of bringing one thought or one action, from conception to completion, at a time, and then when it is where it is supposed to go, moving on to the next in the same manner.

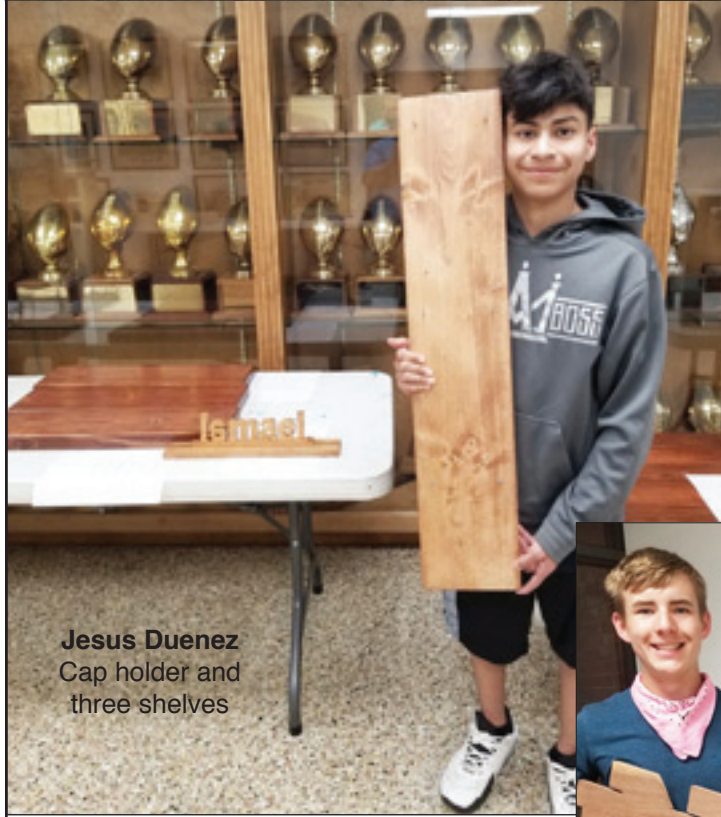

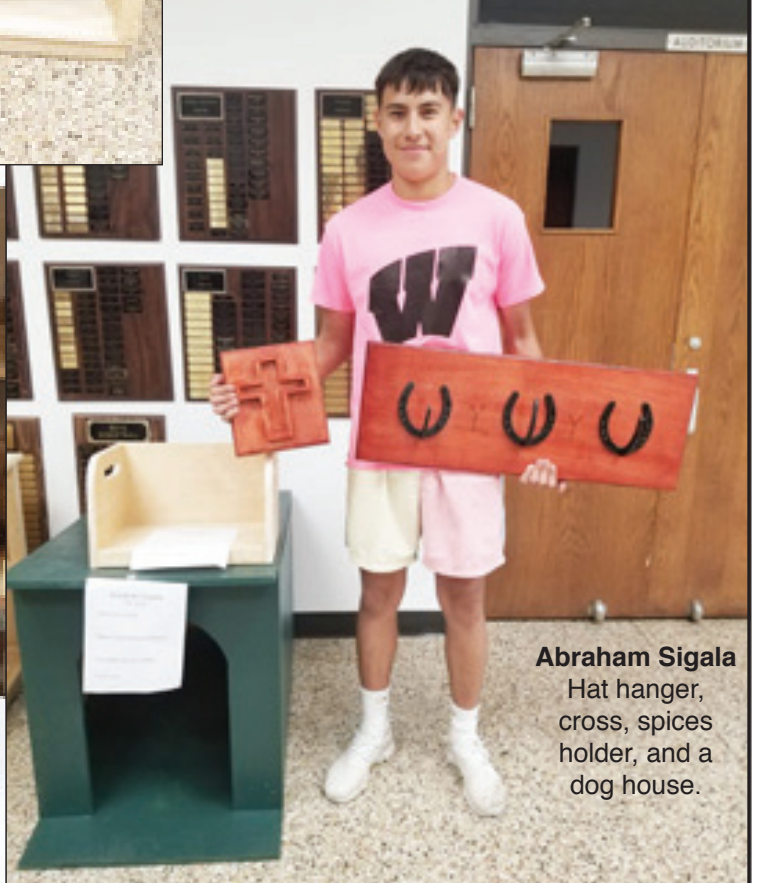

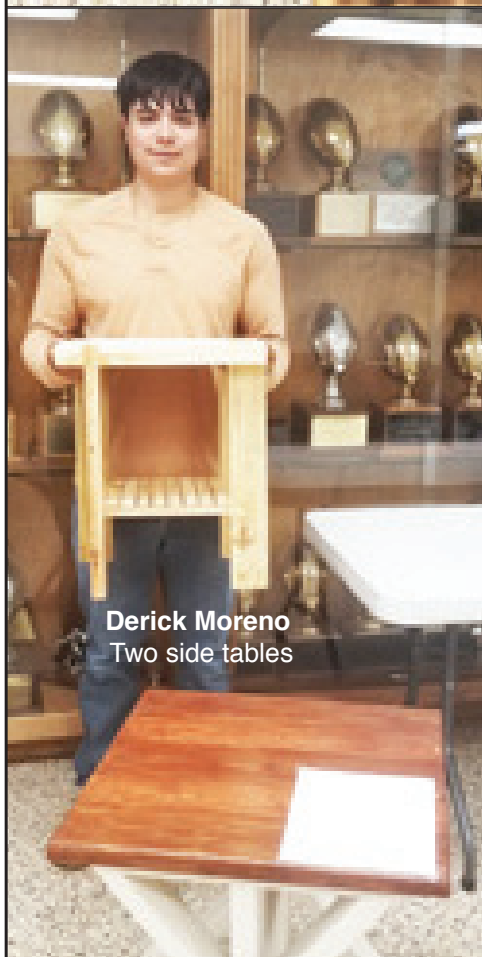
