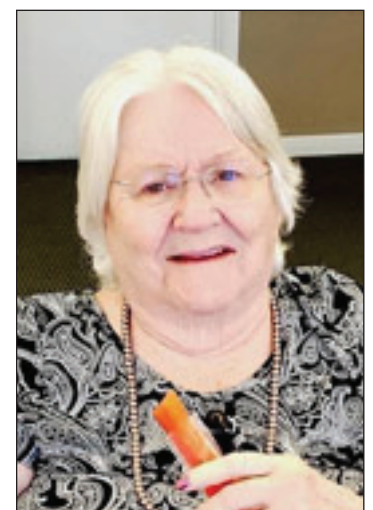

CALL TO ORDER AND PRAYER: Pam Hibler, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. with a prayer offered by Ken Daughtry. Each generation stands on the shoulders of the one that preceded it. This means they ought to be able to reach higher than their forebears. Just yesterday I copied an idea I had seen from a family member, about a better way to organize an item I

use, in a way that takes up less functional space but is also more usable than how I had previously stored it. This is an example of standing on the shoulders of others. This transmission of knowledge, ideas, and solutions can be called collective intelligence,

and is a shortcut that can save years of time and trouble, by consolidating the lessons that our predecessors have learned over the course of decades' experience. It is the fastest way to learn. But sometimes we prefer to learn for ourselves – the slow way,

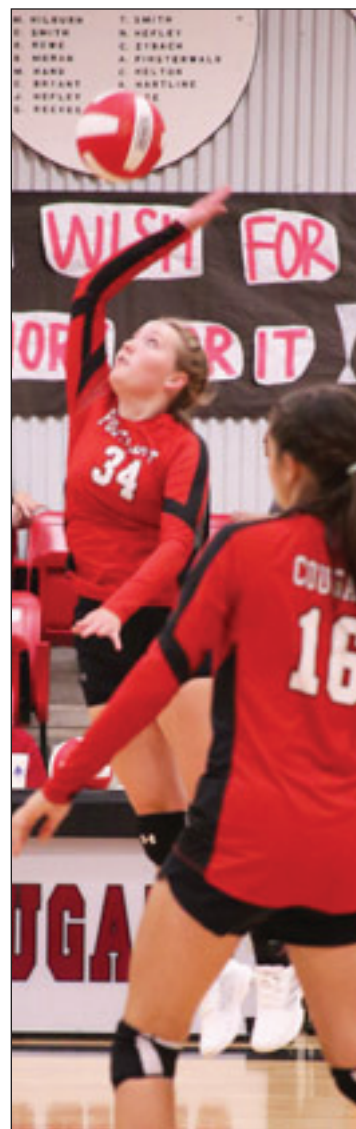
