Students selected for Who's Who Among Students in American Junior Colleges will be recognized as well as the Outstanding Male and Female Students for the 2003-2004 school year.

For the latter award, students are nominated and selected by WTC faculty members based on the following criteria: grade point average, campus involvement, and service to the community.

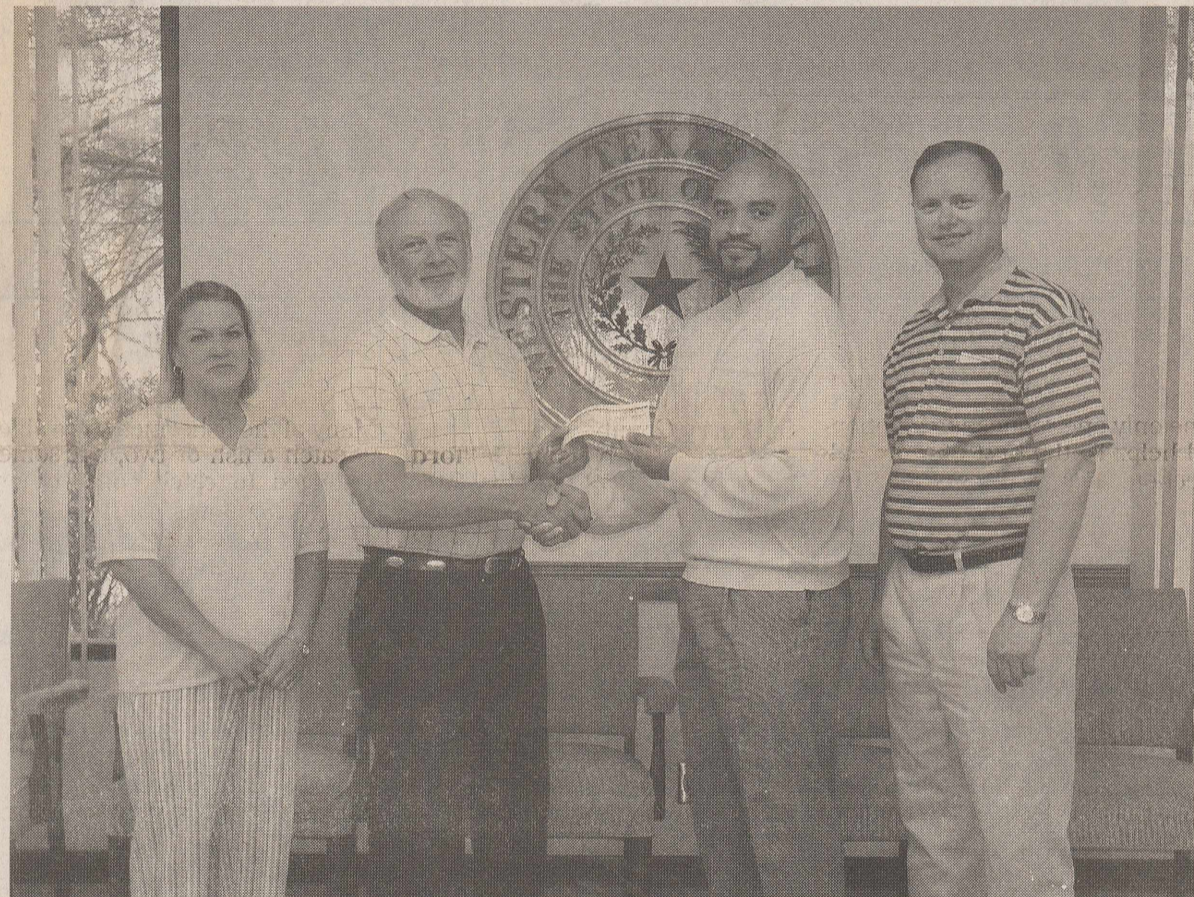
Also, an All USA Academic Team Nominee will be honored during the ceremony.

It's Time For Summer Session Pre-Registration

Pre-Registration for the Summer Session begins on Monday, April 27 and continues thru July 30. Students should come by or call the Counseling Center at 325.573.8511 ext. 313 to make an appointment to pre-register.

Summer Session is broken down into two sessions, a 6-week session, and a 9-week session. The first session begins on June 1 and ends on July 8, the second session

begins on July 12 and ends on August 19.

Current Students can register for May-mester, Summer Session and Fall classes during this pre-registration time. Class schedules can be found on the website at www.wtc.edu.

May-mester begins May 10 and ends on May 28. The fall semester day classes will begin August 24.

By pre-registering students

can avoid those long lines at registration and get into the classes they want to take before they fill up.

Students who have not passed THEA (formerly TASP) and are in DRE, DMT, and DEN classes must wait until grades are posted.

Registration for the Summer Session is July 1, for the May-mester, May 10 and Fall registration is August 19 and 20.
