ocean traffic abows as great stagna-tion as rall traffic, and millions of tons of shipping here and abroad are rusting away in idleness. Many commodities would not move even if the freight charges on them were abolished enirely, because producers can find no

ne to probibitive freight rates is shown by the following examples:

The Case of the Fruit Growers The troubles of the Colifornia lem wer have attracted much attention. He claims he is unable to ship his product because of the lucreased freight ates. A removal of all the recent inrease of the rate or lemmas would not usig him. He has a rate by sea through the Panama Canal of less than halfas per cent-of the rail rate, yet his mone are not marketed.

The average price of a cantaloupe ald down in New York in the season of 1929 was not quite 11 cents. As hey were retailed at about 25 cents. e is a further profit to somebody

of 14 cents per cantaloupe.

The managers of the propagands for general reduction of freight rates save lost sight of the fact that t tober, 1920, 1,195,821 carloads of coal were moved, being the meximum moved in any month in the preceding two rems, although it was handled at the dvanced freight rates, and we have eard nothing as to coal being produced at a loss or of the coal asine owners going out of business because of existing freight rates.
