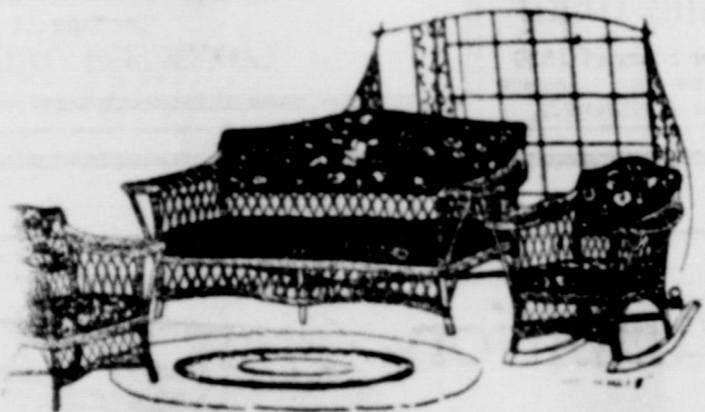

Subject: Peter's Lesson In Trust.

Scripture: Matt. 14: 22-33.
Golden Text: Be of good cheer; it is I; be not afraid.

It seems proper that we attempt to put the lesson in story form today, and attempt to draw some lessons therefrom.

It was late in the afternoon, about sunset. Jesus had had a very busy day in which He had taught the people, healed the sick, comforted the sorrowing and reached a grand climax in the feeding of the five thousand with only five barley loaves and two small fishes. The people were so impressed by this great miracle that they determined to take Him and by force make Him their king. He came into the world to be made a king, but not of an earthly kingdom, nor in the manner in which they would have brought the honor to Him. His was to be a spiritual kingdom, bought by the blood of His life, and established upon the foundation of His atoning death and victorious resurrection. So He dismissed the congregation, insisted that the disciples get into the boat and start the five mile voyage to the other side where they lived, while He went apart, alone into the hills nearby for meditation and prayer. Here we believe is a picture.

Written in the symbolism of the Bible, human life is likened to a voyage over a sea. The disciples here might well represent the human race when at the beginning it was thrust out by the hand of God to make the perilous voyage from Time to Eternity. The disciples started their trip just at sunset, when darkness was gathering. So did humanity make its start just when the darkness brought by sin was settling down upon the world. For the greater part of the night the disciples were alone, beaten by a storm, driven backward, defeated and unable to make progress toward the shore where was rest and home and love ones. So with humanity. For four thousand years, the patriarchs, prophets and fathers battled alone with the maddening, contrary waves of sin and iniquity. But at the fourth watch Jesus came to them walking on the water, a mysterious but welcome visitor.

And so He did for the world. When men were ready to give up in despair. When the world was given to sin and death, He came with righteousness and life to deliver them. Here is another illustration that the darkest hour is just before the dawn. Just when the disciples were ready to give up and drift with the wind to certain death, Jesus appeared unexpectedly walking upon the water and brought them on their way home. In like manner He has come into the lives of men in all generations and helped them on their way home just when they have given up all hope. He is like that. Man's extremity is said to be God's opportunity, and this incident would seem to prove the truthfulness of the saying. He never comes into a life to save until that life realizes that it is helpless to save itself, then He comes in His own mysterious way and relieves its fears and brings it to its desired haven.

Upon the sea of Life we see millions of human barques drift from the shores of Time inevitably on to the shores of Eternity, we find the winds constantly contrary. We cannot hope to stem the tide, and overcome the contrary winds alone. But let us never forget that there is One who at our call will come even in the fourth watch, and by His power over opposing forces, bring us at last into the harbor of eternal safety, home and rest. There we shall drop the gang plank to the shores of sweet deliverance, and walk ashore to be at home in the sun clad city of God. To attempt the voyage alone and unassisted is to fail, drift aimlessly driven and tossed by the stormy winds, until our boat is dashed to splinters upon some unknown shore, and our souls lost in the darkness of eternal despair.

Those who hear His voice in the night, above the noise of the tempest as He says, "It is I; be not afraid," and take Him on board, need not fear the outcome of life. They how have Jesus with them arrive at the desired destination.

WHY NOT BEAUTIFY YOUR YARD?

A house and a home is judged a great deal by the appearance of the yard. Every one knows that every part of the yard should be neat and clean but—that is not all to do.

A lawn is the first essential for a beautiful yard. It should be even, well kept, edges well cut and left in wide open spaces and it should not be cut up with fancy shaped flower beds or individual bushes. Neither should it be cluttered nor dotted with curiosities conspicuously placed, such as piles of stone, old rocks, shells, wires or pieces of statuary.

Informally placed groups of trees on the back and sides of the grounds gives a natural setting to the house.

Shrubs should be planted at the corners, around the porch, and at the base of the house to conceal the more or less rough foundation and tie the building to the ground and to its surroundings.

Sometimes it is desirable to divide the front and back yard with a border of plantings. High and more permanent plantings should form the back ground, while annuals and lower plants are placed in the foreground.

The yard should not be cut up and spotted with fancy shaped flower beds. This is for parks. Flowers are properly used in front of borders and back grounds of shrubbery.

Plan to have a succession of bloom throughout the growing season. If plants blooming at the same time are planted near one another select those with flowers that harmonize in color.
