Clarence Church, Commissioner, Precinct No. 1;  
C. W. Roberts, Commissioner, Precinct No. 2; W. F. McLaurin,

Commissioner, Precinct No. 3; G. W. Turner, Commissioner, Precinct No. 4; and among other proceedings had were the following:  
WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court of Lynn County, Texas deems it advisable to submit to the resident qualified taxpayers voters of said County, who own taxable property in said County and who have duly rendered same for taxation, propositions for the issuance of bonds of said County, for the purpose herein-after stated; therefore  
BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF

LYNN COUNTY, TEXAS:  
That an election be held in said County on the 24th day of March, 1951 which date is not less than Fifteen (15) nor more than Thirty (30) days from the date of the adoption of this order, at which election the following propositions shall be submitted to the qualified taxpayers electors who own taxable property in said County and who have duly rendered the same for taxation, for their action thereupon:

**PROPOSITION NUMBER 2**  
"SHALL the Commissioners' Court of Lynn County, Texas, be authorized to issue the bonds of said County in the principal sum of ONE HUNDRED TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$110,000) to mature serially within any given number of years not to exceed Twenty Five (25) years from the date thereof, to bear interest at a rate not to exceed Three per centum (3 per cent.) per annum, and to levy a tax sufficient to pay the interest on said bonds and create a sinking fund sufficient to pay the principal thereof at maturity for the purpose of erecting the County Jail to be located in the City of Tahoka, in Lynn County, Texas, the County seat of said County, pursuant to authority conferred by Chapters 1 and 2, Title 22, Revised Civil Statutes of 1925!"

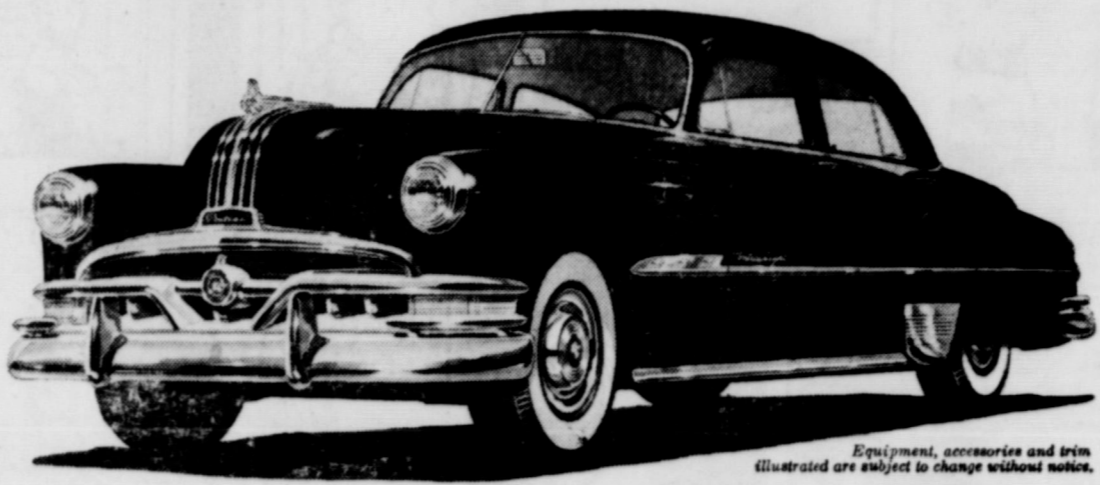

"SHALL the Commissioners' Court of Lynn County, Texas, be authorized to issue the principal sum of NINETY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$90,000) to mature serially within any given number of years not to exceed Twenty Five (25) years from date thereof to bear interest at a rate not to exceed THREE PER CENTUM (3 per cent.) per annum, and to levy a tax sufficient to pay the interest on said bonds and create a sinking fund sufficient to pay the principal thereof at maturity for the purpose of making and permanent improvements and repairs to the County Courthouse, located in the City of Tahoka, in Lynn County, Texas, the County Seat of said County, pursuant to authority conferred by Chapters 1 and 2, Title 22, Revised Civil Statutes of 1925?"

**PROPOSITION NUMBER 2**  
"SHALL the Commissioners' Court of Lynn County, Texas, be authorized to issue the principal sum of ONE HUNDRED TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$110,000) to mature serially within any given number of years not to exceed Twenty Five (25) years from the date thereof, to bear interest at a rate not to exceed Three per centum (3 per cent.) per annum, and to levy a tax sufficient to pay the interest on said bonds and create a sinking fund sufficient to pay the principal thereof, at maturity for the purpose of erecting the County Jail to be located in the City of Tahoka, in Lynn County, Texas, the County seat of said County, pursuant to authority conferred by Chapters 1 and 2, Title 22, Revised Civil Statutes of 1925?"

ALL VOTERS who are legally qualified voters of said Lynn County, Texas and who are resident property taxpayers of said County and who have duly rendered their property for taxation, shall be entitled to vote at said election, and the said election shall be held under the provisions of Chapter 1 and 2 Title 22 Revised Civil Statutes of 1925, and the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the ballots for said election shall be prepared in sufficient number and in conformity with House Bill Number 357, passed by the Fifty First Legislature in 1949, and that printed on such ballots shall appear the following propositions:

"FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS AND THE LEVYING OF THE TAX IN PAYMENT THEREOF, AS SUBMITTED IN PROPOSITION NUMBER 1."

"AGAINST THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS AND THE LEVYING OF THE TAX IN PAYMENT THEREOF, AS SUBMITTED IN PROPOSITION NUMBER 1."

"FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS AND THE LEVYING OF THE TAX IN PAYMENT THEREOF, AS SUBMITTED IN PROPOSITION NUMBER 2."

"AGAINST THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS AND THE LEVYING OF THE TAX IN PAYMENT THEREOF, AS SUBMITTED IN PROPOSITION NUMBER 2."
