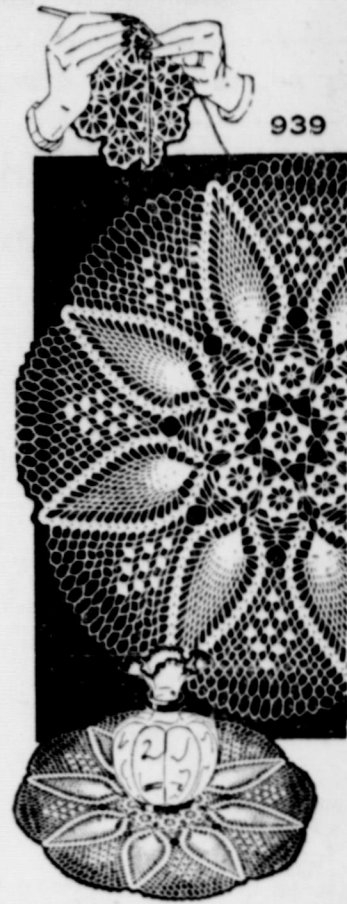

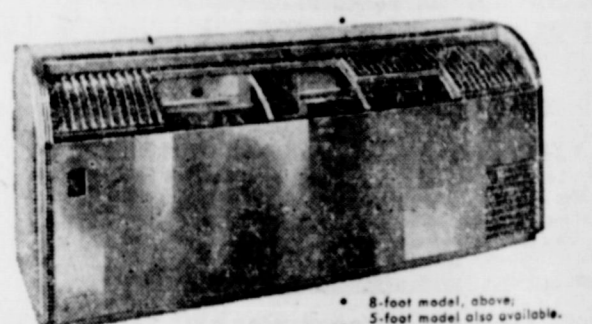

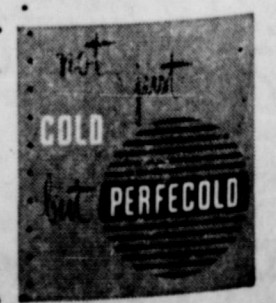

Prevention is Best for Dread Child Disease

Rheumatic heart disease is now the first cause of death among children aged 10 to 14, and is second only to tuberculosis at ages 15 to 25. Despite the importance of this disease its epidemiology is not completely established. No vaccine such as those that prevent typhoid, diphtheria, smallpox, and whooping cough has yet been developed for its prevention or control.

We do know, however, some of the danger signals and with the doctor's accurate diagnosis some of the damaging results of the disease may be prevented.

Exposure to frequent chilling, damp or overcrowded living quarters, a poor diet, an attack of scarlet fever, a bad cold or other infection caused by certain streptococcus germs are likely to be predisposing factors in the appearance of rheumatic fever.

In general the danger signals of rheumatic fever are pain and swelling in the joints of the knee, ankles, elbows or wrist. The pain usually is felt in one of these centers and spreads to the others. Oftentimes a child will get irritable and cross without any visible signs of a good reason for this attitude; he may cry easily or develop habits of nervousness. A physician should be consulted at once in such a situation, for these symptoms may be the beginning of rheumatic fever.

The best safeguards against this disease are to have each child examined at least once a year by a physician, to have the right kind of food and plenty of rest. When the disease is suspected of being present, a doctor should be called.

Sulfathiazole Used Against Calf Scours

Calf scours treatment with vitamin pills or tablets does no good. That's the latest word on the subject from Cornell university. Those in charge of the Cornell work say: "Studies involving approximately 60 heifer calves of various dairy breeds show that supplementing a normal diet with capsules or tablets containing vitamins A, D and E, ascorbic acid, and several of the B vitamins did not reduce the incidence or severity of scours."

Tell's How To Save Your Teeth

Contrary to the popular belief that pyorrhea is incurable, this is only true in the most advanced cases. The state Health Department advises those persons who even suspect the presence of pyorrhea to seek an early diagnosis from their dentist so that proper treatment can be instituted while the disease is still curable.

Early detection and proper treatment of pyorrhea represents the formula for a successful cure. This means that the dentist must have an opportunity to discover the presence of the disease at the earliest possible moment since the symptoms are often so vague that the patient is unaware of its existence. Regular visits to the family dentist are therefore extremely important.

The treatment of pyorrhea is not an involved procedure. In the average early case one of the main therapeutic features is the proper hygienic care of the teeth and the gums as outlined by any reputable dentist. Carelessness regarding mouth hygiene is usually the basic cause for the condition. The family dentist can usually remove the cause of the trouble and when this has been done, intelligent routine home care of the mouth by the patient will effect a cure in the majority of early cases.

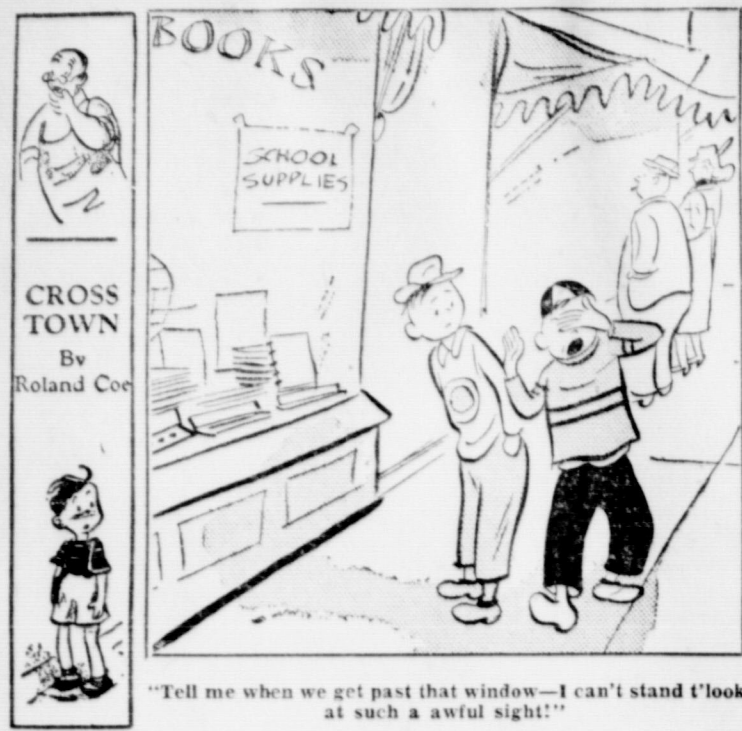
