## New Soil Found In Briscoe County Called "Burson Loam"

Burson loam is the name of a new soil found during the soil survey of Briscoe County says Bob Rauch, District Conservationist, Soil Conservation Service (SCS).  
 Wayburn Mitchell, Soil Scientist

who mapped Briscoe County, was the first to discover this soil. He couldn't make it fit into any soil series classified at that time. So Wayburn carefully described the soil, took samples, and determined its extent. The information was sent to SCS soil correlators. After thorough study of the data, the new soil was approved by the Washington Office.

The Burson soil series has taken its place in the nationwide system of soil classification. Hereafter, any soil found in the country that fits the Burson series classification will be given this name. There are about 10,000 different soil series in the United States.

Soils are named for a local community, town, city, school, or landmark. Burson loam was named after Burson Lake.

The Burson soil is a very shallow, loamy, reddish brown soil over sandstone. It occurs throughout the rough broken country in Briscoe County. It is similar to the Quinlan soil.

Other soils correlated in the Briscoe County survey are Amarillo, Estacado, Miles, Olton, Paloduro, Pullman and Randall.

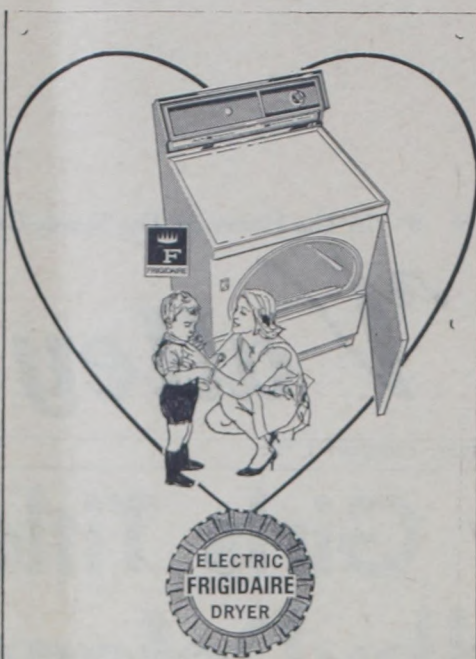

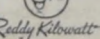
